Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and Chapter 480-80 WAC, please find enclosed for filing the following proposed revision to the WN U-60 Tariff G for electric service of Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (the "Company" or "PSE"):

Fourth Revision of Sheet No. 80-t – General Rules and Provisions (Continued)

The purpose of this filing is to update the pricing for customer-requested additional meter test to reflect current costs. Customers can request one meter test free of charge during a twelve-month period per WAC 480-100-183(1). The proposed meter test charge of \$121 per test is only applicable to each of the additional customer-requested meter test within the twelve-month period if the results of the test show the meter to be either slow or registering within the allowable limits as reported by the Company. If the meter is found to be fast or beyond the allowable limits, PSE will assume the costs of the meter test.

This filing is being made with an issue date of November 9, 2011, and a requested effective date of December 10, 2011. This tariff change does not increase recurring charges or restrict access to services. Posting of the proposed tariff change, as required by WAC 480-100-193, is being made by posting the proposed tariff sheet on the PSE web site immediately prior to, or coincident with, the date of this transmittal letter. Notice of proposed tariff change, as required by law and the Commission's rules and regulations (including WAC 480-100-195), is being given to the public immediately prior to, or coincident with, the date of this transmittal letter through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-100-193. The Company also provides a quote to customers who request an additional meter test prior to scheduling an appointment.
