Revisions to Stericycle of Washington, Inc. Tariff No. 1, Check Sheet, Items 15 and 90

Dear Secretary Danner:

We are attorneys for Stericycle of Washington, Inc. ("Stericycle") and are writing to you in that capacity.

Enclosed for filing are revisions to Stericycle's Tariff No. 1, Check Sheet, Item 15 and Item 90, as shown on the revised tariff pages enclosed with this letter.

Item 90 is being amended to delete the prior rate for the Small Pharmaceutical Waste Box. The Small Pharmaceutical Waste Box is not currently in use by any customers and is being discontinued. The rate stated in the tariff for the Small Pharmaceutical Waste Box is higher than the rate stated for the larger Medium/Large Pharmaceutical Waste Box, so using the Small Box is no longer economical for any generator.

Because these tariff changes proposed do not affect current service to any customer, no notice to customers prior to implementation is planned.
