The primary purpose of this filing and a companion electric tariff filing under Advice No. 2012-08 is to expand the definition of residential service to include adult family homes as required by RCW 70.128.140(2). This law states that “An adult family home must be considered a residential use of property for zoning and public and private utility rate purposes”. In addition, this filing incorporates a number of housekeeping changes, such as capitalization of defined terms used in rule 2 to bring attention to the fact that certain terms are defined. This filing also clarifies several definitions and adds a definition of “non-residential service”.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect issue dates of April 16, 2012, and effective dates of May 17, 2012. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by law and the Commission’s rules and

regulations, is being completed immediately prior to or coincident with the date of this transmittal letter through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-90-193.
