Dear Mr. Danner:

Attached you will find the Spokane Industrial Park Water Company's request for permission to raise its rates. The proposed rates would increase revenues to the Company by \$18,057, or 15 percent annually.

Spokane Industrial Park Water Company has not increased water rates since 2002, and is filing for a rate increase due to increased operating expenses. Operating expenses, including wages, insurance, gas and electric utilities and repair and maintenance expenses have steadily risen over the last ten years.

The table set out below shows the net effect of the increase on the average customer's monthly bill. All customers are metered.

The Company's balance sheet and income statement are already on file at the Commission as part of its annual report.

There are no non-regulated operations. The Spokane Industrial Park Water Company is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Crown West Realty, LLC (Crown West), a New York limited liability company, and has been since Crown West's formation in 1996.

Dear Water Customer:

The Spokane Industrial Park Water Company has filed for a rate increase approval from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission. This will increase rates 15 percent annually. Company-wide, this represents approximately \$18,057 during a twelve month period. If approved, the rates will become effective July 1, 2012 and will be reflected in your August 1, 2012 billing statement.

Because the Spokane Industrial Park Water Company has not increased water rates since 2002, the proposed increase represents an equivalent annual inflation of 1.4%. This rate of increase is lower than the actual rate of inflation over this period and would be insufficient to fully offset the rate of increase in operating expenses, which include wages, insurance, gas and electric utilities and repair and maintenance expenses. The increase is necessary to maintain the current level of service.
