Animals must be properly harnessed and will not be permitted to occupy a seat, but must lie or stand at the feet of its owner. The owner of the animal is liable for any injury/damage caused by animal while onboard.

#### APPLICATION OF FARES:

#### ARTICLES NOT ACCEPTED AS BAGGAGE

Articles listed below are classified as "Prohibited" and will not be transported under any circumstances; that is, Passengers will not be permitted to Check the Items in Baggage Service or to carry them on the vessel:

#### (1) Articles Prohibited by Law:

Acids, Batteries containing Liquid Acids, Cylinders containing Compressed Gases (See NOTE), Combustible Liquids, Explosives, Flammable Films, Fireworks, Flammable Materials, Gases, Hazardous (Dangerous) Articles such as; Poisons, Gases, Radioactive Materials, Flammable Articles.
