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**REPORTS AS REQUIRED BY WAC 480-123-070
AND WAC 480-123-080**

Skyline Telecom (the "Company") hereby submits the following reports in accordance with WAC 480-123-070 and WAC 480-123-080.¹

Report 1: WAC 480-123-070(1)(a): Attached is a copy of the Company's NECA-1 Report for the calendar year 2011, that, as of the date of the report, the Company has reported as the basis for support from the federal high-cost fund.

Report 2: WAC 480-123-070(1)(b): The Company reports that the investments and expenses reported under Report 1, above, benefited customers as follows:

Through the expenditure of these funds, the Company was able to continue to provide services at a level that the Company believes meets the intent of providing quality telecommunications services to customers in the service area for which the Company is designated as an ETC.² The Company has made substantial investments over the past several years which allow it to provide quality telecommunications services to all of its customers even before the Company began to receive federal high-cost funds. These expenditures and investments benefit all customers within the designated ETC service area. The Company offers services comparable to services offered in urban areas at rates comparable to such urban areas.

Throughout 2011 the Company has also continued to provide maintenance to buried cable as needed due to winter weather damage and state road issues. The Company also continued to provide and maintain DSL to the exchange in 2011

Report 3: WAC 480-123-070(4): The Company reports that the Company is not aware of any complaints during calendar year 2011 to the Federal Communications

Commission or the Consumer Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Washington concerning the services provided to its customers.

Report 4: WAC 480-123-080(1)(b): The Company reports that newspaper advertisements detailing basic supported services as well as the Lifeline and Link-Up programs were run in The Daily Herald and Okanogan Valley Gazette-Tribune throughout 2011. The Company expects to continue to advertise these services throughout 2012.

Report 5: WAC 480-123-080(1)(b): The Company expects investments and expenditures to remain fairly consistent with prior years in relation to maintenance, replacement and upgrades to our plant. The Company does not anticipate major adjustments in staffing levels for the levels for the relevant period. Customers will continue to receive the high level of telecommunications services that they have experienced over the past few years with the possibility of increased services.

Report 6: WAC 480-123-080(2): The Company expects investments and expenditures to remain fairly consistent with prior years in relation to maintenance, replacement and upgrades to our plant. The Company has not yet started the budgeting process for 2013 and therefore does not have the final numbers prepared for investments and expense levels for 2013. The Company does not anticipate major adjustments to staffing levels in 2013. Customers will continue to receive the high level of telecommunications service that they have experienced over the past few years with the possibility of increased services. The Company expects that the continued receipt of federal high-cost support will allow the Company to continue to provide the supported services at rates comparable to the rates for such services in urban areas to all customers in the designated ETC service area.



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**AFFIDAVIT CONTAINING CERTIFICATIONS

I, Delinda Kluser, being of lawful age, state that I am Vice-Pres of Finance and General Manager of Skyline Telecom (“Company”), that I am authorized to execute this Affidavit on behalf of the Company, and that the facts set forth in this Affidavit are true to the best of my knowledge, information and belief. On this basis, I hereby certify to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (“Commission”) for use by the Commission in providing the certification to the Federal Communications Commission and Universal Service Administrative Company required by 47 C.F.R. §54.314, as follows:

(1) That all federal high-cost support provided to the Company within the State of Washington has been used in the preceding calendar year and will be used in the coming calendar year only for the provision, maintenance and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended;

(2) That during the 2011 calendar year, the Company met substantially the applicable service quality standard found in WAC 480-123-030(1)(h);

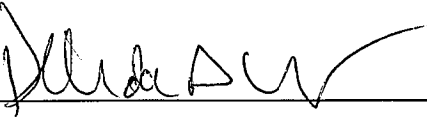
