Revisions to Blue Sky Tariff Schedules

Advice 12-06

Pursuant to RCW 80.28.050, RCW 80.28.060, and WAC 480-80-121, PacifiCorp, d.b.a. Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp or the Company), submits for filing in electronic format proposed tariff sheet revisions to Schedule Nos. 70.1, Renewable Energy Rider – Optional and 73.1, Renewable Energy Rider – Optional Bulk Purchase Option (a.k.a "Blue Sky"). The Company submits these proposed changes to allow for all customers in PacifiCorp's Washington service territory to participate in Blue Sky programs.

First Revision of Sheet No. 70.1 Schedule 70 Renewable

First Revision of Sheet No. 73.1 Schedule 73

Renewable Energy Rider -Optional Bulk Purchase Option

Background

The Company is proposing to update the "Applicable" section of tariff sheets 70.1 and 73.1 as follows:

- 1. Remove references to specific schedules;
- 2. Add language that encompasses all of the Company's customer schedules for tariff sheet 70.1 and all of the Company's non-residential customer schedules for tariff sheet 73.1.

The Company's intent has always been to make the Blue Sky programs available to all of its electric service customers. Since the Company's tariff schedules are subject to change, the current language in the above referenced Application sections of tariff sheets 70.1 and 73.1 unintentionally excludes the customers on new rate schedules. proposed modification makes the Blue Sky program available to all Washington customers and removes the administrative burden of constant review of the Company's rate schedules for additions and removals.

PacifiCorp hereby submits a clean copy of Sheet Nos. 70.1 and 73.1 containing the proposed revisions and respectfully requests Commission approval of these tariff modifications with an October 28, 2012 effective date.
