Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060, WAC 480-80-101 and -105, please find enclosed for filing the following proposed revision to the WN U-60, Tariff G for electric service of Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (the "Company" or "PSE"):

WN U-60, Tariff G, Electric Service:

The purpose of this filing is to provide the option of light emitting diode ("LED") lighting within the Company's existing Schedule 54, Customer-Owned Street Lighting Energy Service, Sodium Vapor and

under Schedule 51, to extend the sizes of LED fixtures available while adjusting the operation and maintenance cost component and clarifying the availability of service. This filing facilitates customers being able to choose the option of LED service in anticipation of State funding being available to municipalities for municipal LED lighting conversions. The work papers supporting these proposed revisions are enclosed.

The availability section of Schedule 51 has been clarified and a provision added to allow adjustment of the minimum term for lighting systems acquired by the Company based on the estimated remaining life and purchase price. Also a provision was added to clarify that the Company has no obligation to install overhead circuitry or acquire an existing lighting system. With the addition of rates for common LED luminaire sizes the rate calculation methodology was removed from the monthly rate section of the schedule. Finally, the adjustment section of Schedule 51 was revised to reflect language that will be incorporated in all lighting schedules.

Schedule 54 currently prohibits new installations, additions or relocations of the existing fixtures, To allow existing installations to be converted to LED luminaires the schedule has been modified and rates for the common sizes of LED luminaires was added. As with Schedule 51 the adjustment section was revised to reflect language common to all lighting schedules. Finally, a new section titled "Conversion to LED" was added to enable the conversion.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect issue dates of November 2, 2012, and effective dates of December 3, 2012. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by law and the Commission's rules and regulations, is being completed immediately prior to or coincident with the date of this transmittal letter through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-100-193. Pursuant to WAC 480-100-195(3) notice to customers will be provided in accordance with the method that the Company posts its tariffs as required by WAC 480-100-193.
