



In regard to the questions set forth on Attachment A:

CUSA CSS, LLC, the Seller, along with several of its parent and subsidiary companies (collectively, the "Debtors"), filed voluntary bankruptcy petitions on January 3, 2012, in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "Bankruptcy Court"), and are being jointly administered therein under Case No. 12-10010 (KG) (collectively, the "Bankruptcy Case"). Pursuant to the terms of a motion for authority to sell substantially all of the assets of the Debtors, including all of the assets of the Seller, filed in the Bankruptcy Case on January 13, 2012, and an order authorizing the sale of substantially all of the assets of the Seller entered on May 25, 2012, Professional Transportation, Inc., the Buyer, acquired from the Seller substantially all of the Seller's assets, including its Interstate Authorities (the "Transaction").

In connection with the Transaction, the Seller and the Buyer filed with the Surface Transportation Board (the "STB") on June 12, 2012, an application for permanent approval under 49 U.S.C. § 14303(a), under STB Docket No. MCF-21046. The Transaction by which the Buyer, Professional Transportation, Inc., acquired the assets of the Seller, CUSA CSS, LLC, was approved by the STB by a decision published on August 17, 2012.

Neither Seller nor Buyer is aware of any fines or penalties owed to the Commission. To the knowledge of the Seller, no closing safety report has been filed with the Commission. Seller does not have any remaining employees with knowledge of the any fines or penalties owed to the Commission or any closing safety report. However, for the reason set forth below, Seller and Buyer submit that a response to the foregoing items is not required.

49 U.S.C. § 14303(f) specifically preempts any state action that would interfere with the consummation of a Board approved or exempted merger, consolidation or acquisition of control. Pursuant to 49 CFR § 1182.8(f), "If completion of a transaction requires the transfer of operating authorities or registrations from one or more parties to others, the parties shall comply with relevant procedures of the Office of Motor Carriers of the U.S. Department of Transportation, and comply with ministerial requirements of relevant State procedures.

Seller and Buyer submit that the application to which this statement is attached complies with the requirements of "complying with ministerial requirements of relevant State procedures," as required by 49 CFR § 1182.8(f).

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

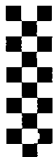
