

## PREPROPOSAL STATEMENT OF INQUIRY

Agency: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission)	
<b>Subject of possible rule making:</b> The Commission is considering whether to streamline its procedures and associated rules for common carriers (WAC 480-14) and household goods carriers (WAC 480-15) when the Commission receives notice that a carrier's liability insurance is scheduled to lapse. Instead of providing multiple notices that the carrier's operating authority will be canceled, the Commission is considering providing only one notice. In addition, the Commission is considering whether to make revisions to correct and clarify certain household goods carrier rules in WAC 480-15. Docket TV-130079.	
Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 80.01.040, RCW 81.01.010 and RCW 81.80.130.	
Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: Streamlining the insurance and cancellation procedures for common carriers and household goods carriers will benefit both the industry and the Commission. The industry will receive less paperwork from the Commission and the Commission will reduce staff time, paper and mailing costs now expended on multiples notices to carriers.
