## Dear Valued Customer,

Waste Management is pleased to be your solid waste services collection provider. We are writing to notify you of an upcoming rate adjustment.

Like all of us, the garbage industry is faced with many challenges today. Rising costs for disposal, labor, fuel, maintenance and office expenses have resulted in increased costs for us to provide collection services. All of the above-mentioned costs have risen since our last general rate increase in January, 2009; nearly four years ago. Accordingly, we have applied for an increase in rates, subject to the review and approval of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC). The UTC, upon completing its investigation, has the authority to set final rates that may be either lower or higher from the proposed rates shown on the back of this letter. If approved, the new rates would become effective March 5, 2013.

The UTC is scheduled to make a decision at its open meeting on February 28, 2013.
