I Would like to expand my Authority to

(but excluding drop boxes) in that portion of Stevens County Described as follows. Beginning at the intersection of centerline of kettle River (also Stevens - Ferry County line) and south line of Section 32, T38N, R37E, then east along the south line of said section extended to the Northwest corner of section 6, T37N, R40E, south along the west line of section 6, T37N, R40E, extended to the southwest corner of Section 19, T37N, R40E, then east along the south line of said section extended to the southeast corner of section 21 T37N, R41E, then north along the east line of said section projected due north to its intersection with the north line of Section 4, T40N, R41E (also the US-Canadian border) then west along the north line of said section extended to its intersection with the Stevens - Ferry county line then south along the said county line to its intersection with the south line of section 32, T38n, R37E, the point of beginning. We basically want to close the gap between Couse's Sanitation and Sunshine Disposal. We would like the Northwest corner of Steven county if possible.

We took over this authority March 2011, and since then We have gotten many requests for garbage services that aren't on our authority and live where there is No Service. With that being said I have received many letter stating that fact.

We have a lot of experience with hauling solid and liquid waste. Not only do we have our garbage routes but we also have a successful septic and portable toilet business, which we have routes also. The portable toilet portion of it work the same way as a garbage route. We have our list of toilets we have to service. The distance traveled is at least twice as far as our garbage routes.

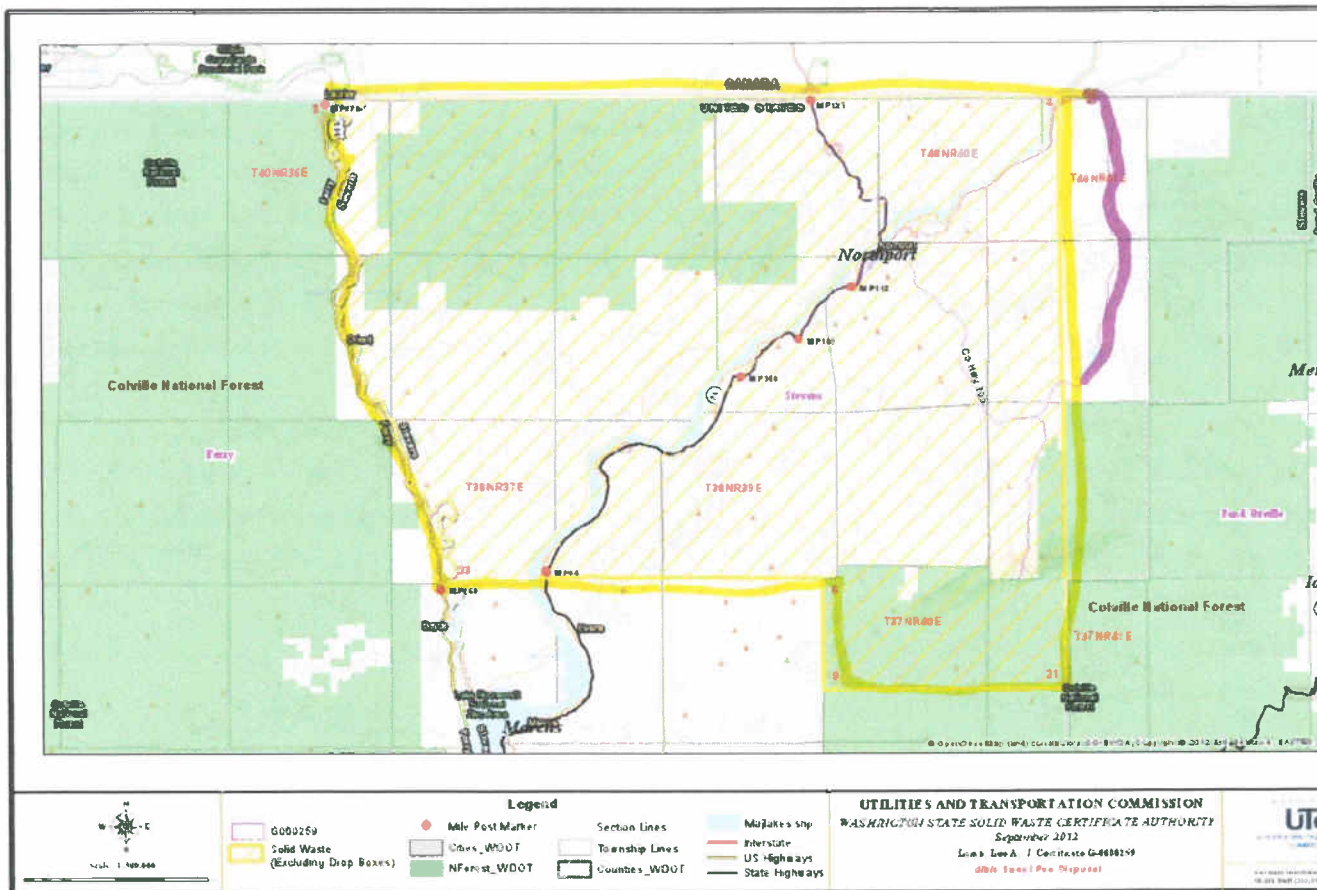

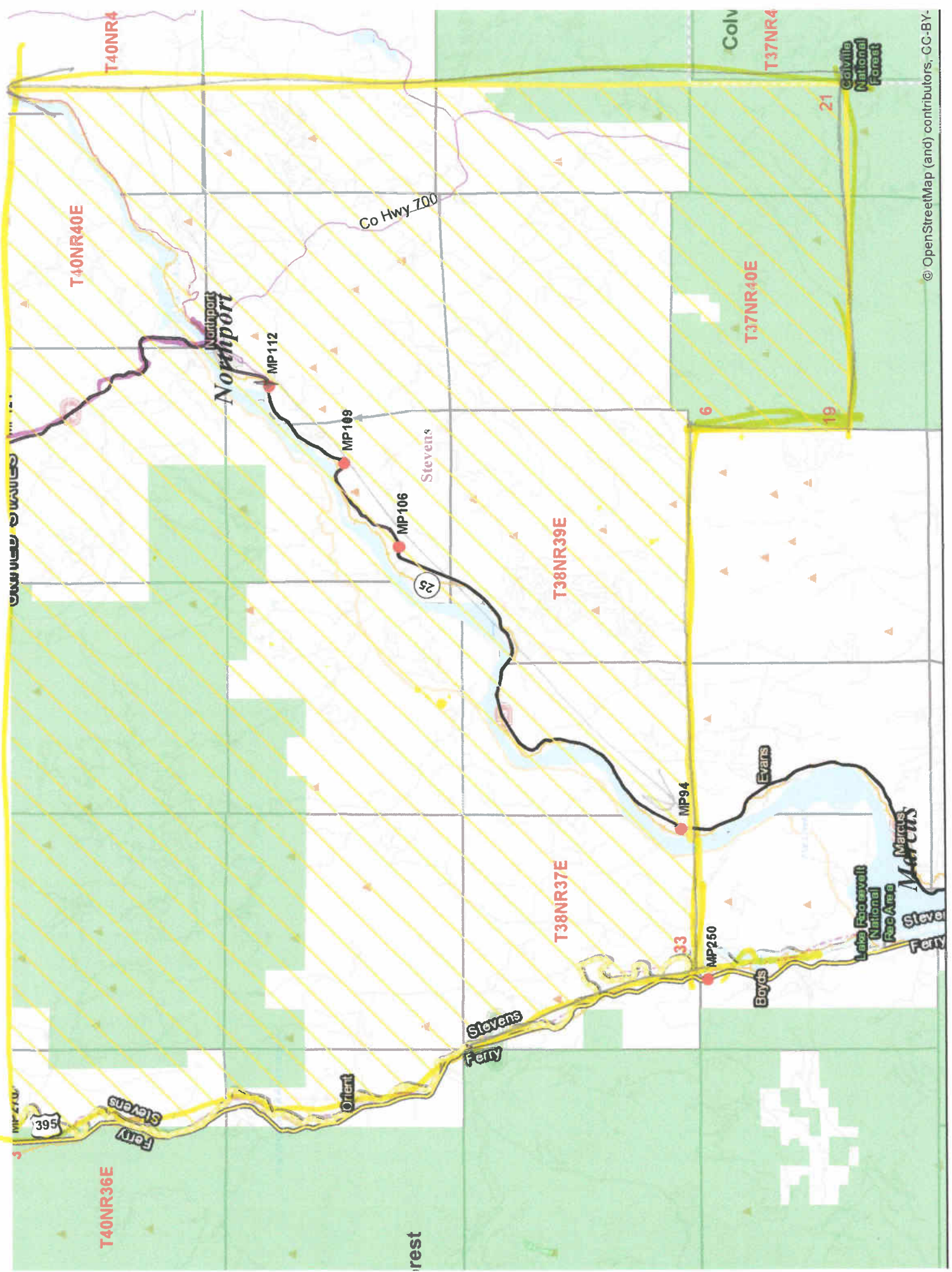

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

On behalf of my company, **Bull Hill Guest Ranch**, I am writing to you in hopes you'll be able to assist us with a garbage service on the Northport Flat Creek Road. Opened in 1995, our business has grown dramatically through the years, where today we employ up to 12 employees (seasonal basis) and host an average of 20-25 guests per day (May-Oct).

We currently do *not* have a garbage service in our area and due to our remote location, and limited manpower and transportation/vehicles, we are in dire need of a garbage/pickup service. We have called numerous people throughout the area, including other garbage service companies and have had no luck in identifying any company and/or individuals that are able to provide service in our area. We live approximately 14 miles south of Northport and approximately 30 miles from Kettle Falls.

Due to the nature of our business, we must be onsite during operating hours (8am-8pm) daily, which makes it extremely difficult to haul our own garbage into Kettle Falls or Northport (the nearest landfill depository).

We desperately need this service, and with the growing number of individuals and families that now live along the Northport Flat Creek Road (the Guglielmino's alone comprise five households in the area), it is critical that this service be provided, not only for sanitary purposes, but for the safety and welfare of all concerned.
