To whom it may concern:

Re: Application-TV130460 withdrawal

I am writing to let you know that I am withdrawing the application-#TV130460 effective today due to not able to complete the purchase of the truck as planned, due to a fraudulent, unfair sales practice from the dealership. I understanding that I could reapply again once my issue is resolved which I anticipate in the next few months.

Below is an explanation to why I need to place the above permit application on hold for the moment.

On 3/25/13, I went to Mid Valley Chrysler-Dodge in Grandview, WA with intent to purchase a truck to start my own trucking business. I test drove a truck and antifreeze spilled from the front radiator, the sales man, assure me that they would fix it before its purchased, but in order to do that I had to pay a retainer of \$3,000.00; which I did! and asked for a promissory note to assure that they would comply. On the 3/27/13 the sales man calls me to tell me that the truck had been repaired and was ready to go. I went to the dealership and at my arrival; the sales man insisted to get all the sales completed and took me to the financial office to finalize the sale. The purchase was completed, I drove off with the truck approximately 2 miles in the freeway and the antifreeze spilled off the radiator again this time was a lot more than a gallon. I immediately called the dealer and spoke with the sales Supervisor and he said that the spill of antifreeze was normal for most trucks!, I told him that it wasn't true!!, that its contaminating the environment, and furthermore that it was illegal!! . Then he said to bring the truck back to the lot and that they would check it again, I went ahead and left it there. On a bout a week I called to see if it was fixed and everyone I spoke with kept given me different excuses, such as; the diesel mechanic was on vacation, they had order a part and that they needed the supervisor approval to fix it. Finally, after 2 weeks, I went in person to speak with the supervisor, he came out of his office, I was in the waiting area with some other folks around me, he looked furious and started yelling at me saying; "you bought the truck as is, take the dam truck out my lot, I'm not going to fix it!!!".

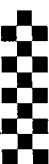

- has a gross combined weight rating of 26,001 pounds that includes a towed unit with a gross vehicle weight rating of more than 10,000 pounds; or
