The tariff sheet provides for the following change:

Cascade's approach to modifying its conservation is two pronged given the reduction in the avoided costs included in our pending IRP. First we re-evaluated how our programs are delivered and then we evaluated their cost. We are bringing a portion of the residential program in-house and will be utilizing a different vendor. This will result in a significant savings to customers, primarily starting in year two after the transition.

Cascade is also proposing to use the Utility Cost Test (UCT) as the primary driver for establishing rebates and cost effectiveness of the Residential program. As a result, Cascade is taking a long term perspective and will be taking advantage of deeper savings by growing and maintaining conservation measures.

The Commercial program has been highly successful and cost effective. Thus, Cascade is proposing very little changes to the Commercial program.

The net effect of the proposed changes show that, on a total portfolio basis for the Residential and Commercial programs, combined they meet the Total Resource Cost (TRC) test.
