Dear Mr. Fredrickson,

This is to notify you that beginning July 1, 2013, disposal rates will increase at the Olympic View Transfer Station (OVTS). This rate adjustment was based on the findings of a recently-completed cost of service/rate study. The Kitsap County Board of Commissioners adopted these new rates by resolution (Resolution No.056-2013, "A Resolution Amending the fees charged at the Olympic View Transfer Station") on April 8, 2013. Please note that this resolution also includes rate increases to be effective January 1, 2015 and January 1, 2017. The new rates are shown in the table on the reverse side of this letter.

Kitsap County Public Works Solid Waste Division, as owner of OVTS, is providing the required minimum seventy-five days' notice of the changes in tipping fees and disposal rate schedules, in accordance with RCW 70.95.212. This notification is to provide solid waste collection companies sufficient time to prepare and submit tariffs and rate filings for public comment and commission approval.
