Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060, WAC 480-80-101 and -105, please find enclosed for filing the following proposed revisions to the WN U-2, tariff for natural gas service of Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (the "Company" or "PSE"):

WN U-2, Natural Gas Service:

6th Revision of Sheet No. 42 - Rule No. 28: Income Tax Rider-Contributions in Aid of Construction

The purpose of this filing is to update a certain tariff rate that was impacted by Order No. 07, Final Order Authorizing Rates in the consolidated Docket Nos. UE-130137 and 130138 (the "Order") issued by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (the "UTC") on June 25, 2013.

The revised tariff sheet No. 42 sets forth proposed updates to the rate in Rule 28: Income Tax Rider-Contributions in Aid of Construction to reflect the latest overall rate of return and capital structure approved by the UTC in the Order. The work paper supporting the proposed revision is enclosed as Attachment A to this filing. A revised tariff sheet regarding the electric service income tax rider, Schedule 87, is also being filed at this time under Advice No. 2013-13.

The tariff sheet described herein reflect an issue date of July 22, 2013, and effective date of September 1, 2013. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by law and the Commission's rules and regulations, is being completed immediately prior to or coincident with the date of this transmittal letter through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-90-193. In addition each customer is provided notice through a quoted cost prior to incurring the charge, therefore notice will be provided to each customer through the cost quote.
