The purpose of this filing is to accomplish a number of housekeeping changes. These changes include:


- Changing the 144th Revision of Sheet 101-A to reflect incorporating the changes that were made on the 142nd Revision of Sheet 101-A which were then subsequently not included on the 143rd revision of Sheet 101-A. Not including the revisions on the 143rd revision was not requested or noted in the cover letter accompanying the 143rd revision or coded on the tariff sheet. In order to reflect that changes had been made on this 144th revision, the tariff sheet has been coded in the same manner as 142nd revision, with (K) and (M). The changes include (1) including the cities of Clyde Hill, Covington, Des Moines, DuPont, Duvall, and Eatonville which were inadvertently excluded on the 143rd revision; (2) deleting the cities of North Bend, Olympia, and Orting (which also already appear on sheet 101-B); and (3) deleting the limitations for the City of Everett (which also already appear on sheet 101-C).
- Updating the sheets shown above from Sheet No. 123 through Sheet No. 187T-A by changing the rates from cents to dollars and other minor changes.
- Updating Sheet 1141-A to remove a parenthesis.
- Clarifying Sheet 1142-D to reflect that the gas procurement credit is charged per therm.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect issue dates of October 9, 2013, and effective dates of November 16, 2013. Posting of the proposed tariff change for public inspection and review, as required by law and the Commission's rules and regulations, is being completed immediately prior to or coincident with the date of this transmittal letter, through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-90-193(1).

This filing does not represent an increase in recurring charges or restrictions in access to services, therefore notice will be provided in accordance with the provisions of WAC 480-90-194(3).
