Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and Chapter 480-80 WAC, please find enclosed for the filing of following proposed revision to the WN U-2 tariff for natural gas service of Puget Sound Energy, Inc. ("PSE"):

WN U-2 Natural Gas Service:

Sixth Revision of Sheet No. 104 - Miscellaneous Charges

The purpose of this filing is to update the trip charge in Schedule No.4, Miscellaneous Charges. The proposed charge is \$72, a \$6 increase from the current charge of \$66, to reflect the 2013 labor and overhead costs. The supporting work paper contains proprietary information therefore PSE will provide it to the Commission via the data request process.

The proposed tariff change does not increase recurring charges or restrict access to services. The trip charge applies whenever a customer requests a non-emergency service call to be performed outside of normally scheduled service hours, PSE will provide the information about the trip charge prior to scheduling such a service call.

The trip charge does not apply to any safety-related services provided under Rule No. 24, Sheet Nos. 38 and 38-A. All emergency services are provided at no charge to the requesting customer as described in the Inspection Services section of Rule No. 24.

This filing is being made with an issue date of November 14, 2013, and a requested effective date of January 1, 2014. Posting and notice of the proposed tariff change, as required by law and the Commission's rules and regulations, is being given to the public immediately prior to, or coincident with, the date of this transmittal letter through web, telephone, and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-90-193 and WAC 480-90-195.
