Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and WAC 480-80-101 and WAC 480-80-105(1)(c), please find enclosed for filing the following proposed revisions to the WN U-60, Tariff G for electric service of Puget Sound Energy (the “Company”):

The purpose of this filing is to implement a municipal tax within the City of Edgewood (the “City”). A copy of the approved City ordinance, Ordinance No. 13-0401 is enclosed.

The enclosed ordinance implements a 2.67 percent utility tax rate which will sunset automatically on January 1, 2020. The Company estimates the resulting annualized increase in gross revenues from electric operations and corresponding increase in taxes due to be \$172,464.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect issue dates of November 22, 2013, and effective dates of January 1, 2014. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by law and the Commission’s rules and regulations, is being completed through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-100-193. Pursuant to WAC 480-100-195 notice to customers will be provided in the first billing after the tariff revision becomes effective; the customers within the City will receive notification in the form of a bill message.
