Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and Chapter 480-80 WAC, please find enclosed for filing the following proposed revision to the WN U-60, Tariff G for electric service of Puget Sound Energy (the "Company" or "PSE").

11<sup>th</sup> Revision of Sheet No. 194 – Residential and Farm Energy Exchange Benefit

The purpose of this filing is to make changes which allow the Company to administer the pass-through of the Residential and Farm Energy Exchange Benefit (the "Benefit") in the same manner as the Bonneville Power Administration ("BPA") provides the benefit to PSE. Specifically, the changes provide that customers are not eligible to receive the Benefit until PSE receives information from the customer and determines based on that information that the customer is eligible. The revisions also provide for removal of the Benefit if customers fail to return a questionnaire regarding eligibility. BPA has recently required utilities participating in the exchange to send customers such questionnaires and requires that utilities retain copies to justify continued receipt of the Benefit.

The tariff sheet described herein reflects an issue date of December 11, 2013, and an effective date of January 11, 2014. Posting of proposed tariff change, as required by WAC 480-100-193, is being made by posting the proposed tariff sheets on the PSE web site immediately prior to, or coincident with, the date of this transmittal letter in accordance with WAC 480-100-193(1).

This filing will not result in an increase in customer bills or restrict access to service therefore the Company will publish the change in accordance with WAC 480-100-195(3) by publishing the tariff change in accordance with WAC 480-100-193, by posting the proposed change on its web site.
