The purpose of this filing is to remove the Local Service Guarantee Credit Program. This is an outdated program that the Company no longer wishes to offer. The market environment for providing telecommunication services has changed greatly since this offering was first tariffed. The Company provides other services in addition to voice line services, and it has different credit and saving incentive programs. These credit programs, which are more dynamic than the current LSG offering, are constantly reviewed and modified in order to meet customer's unique situations and the ever changing telecommunications marketplace. The Company will follow state rules on repates at a minimum, but may provide additional credits depending on the situation and services. In addition, the Company is adding its Service Interruption language to reference the state rules and to be consistent with the Asotin Tariff.

The proposed effective date is January 15, 2014.
