The primary purpose of this filing is to implement changes to allow customers to take advantage of more efficient LED and sodium vapor lighting by providing for the conversion of mercury vapor lighting to LED or sodium vapor and movement of those converted lights to Schedule 53 or Schedule 54, as appropriate. This filing also reflects the addition of compact fluorescent lights to Schedule 50.

This filing does not increase rates for existing lights, but rather allows and encourages the use of more efficient lighting that uses less electricity per lumen.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect issue dates of April 17, 2014, and effective dates of May 30, 2014. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by WAC 480-100-193, is being made by posting the proposed tariff sheets on the PSE web site immediately prior to or coincident with the date of this transmittal letter.
