**GRADE CROSSING PROTECTIVE FUND  
2013 – 2015 GRANT APPLICATION  
IMPROVEMENTS AT PUBLIC PASSIVE RAILROAD CROSSINGS**

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission), through its Grade Crossing Protective Fund (GCPF), provides grants for projects that eliminate or mitigate public safety hazards at railroad crossings and along railroad rights-of-way in Washington State. As part of this emphasis the Commission is also committed to improving safety at public, passively-protected railroad crossings in Washington. GCPF funds may be used for purchasing stop signs<sup>1</sup>, yield signs, retro-reflective tape, posts (if required), retro-reflective cross buck signs, and emergency notification signs to a maximum of \$250 for each crossing. Under this program, GCPF funds may not be used for labor costs. All installations must be MUTCD compliant.

## Columbia Basin Railroad cross buck assembly updates to meet the new MUTCD standards.

Columbia Basin Railroad will be installing new longer post where needed for the height of the new added yield or stop signs to meet the MUTCD sign height. And will also install new cross bucks with two inch wide white reflective tape on each back side of the cross buck signs along with two inch wide white reflective tape on the back side of the post. We have already installed white tape on the fronts of each post in 2013 that can be removed and installed on a new post if one is needed for that crossing.

4"x4"x16' post each \$22.00 Total post #95 =2,090.00

Cross Buck each \$37.00 Total x buck #95 = 3,515.00

30"x30" stop sign each \$27.00 Total stop signs #4 =108.00

36"x36" yield sign each \$21.00 Total yield signs #91 =1,911.00
