Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and Chapter 480-80 WAC, please find enclosed for filing the following proposed revision to the WN U-60, Tariff G for electric service of Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (“PSE”).

The purpose of this filing is to update and extend the effectiveness of electric conservation program Schedule 258, Large Power User Self-Directed Program.

A mark-up draft of Schedule 258 was included in PSE’s filing of its 2015 Annual Conservation Plan in Docket No. UE-132043 on December 1, 2014. PSE’s Conservation Resource Advisory Group (CRAG) also received a draft of the mark-up version in its November 1 presentation, consistent with condition (8)(a) in Attachment A of Order 01 in Docket No. UE-132043.

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The revisions contained in these updated Schedules 83 and 258 are updates of the four-year program timeframe. The current Schedule 258 four-year program cycle expires at the end of 2014. The revised program cycle allows large power users to participate in the self-directed program from 2015 through 2018.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect issue dates of December 9, 2014, and effective dates of January 9, 2015. Posting of the proposed tariff change, as required by WAC 480-100-193, is being made by posting the proposed tariff sheets on the PSE web site immediately prior to, or coincident with, the date of this transmittal letter in accordance with WAC 480-100-193(1). Since this filing does not propose to increase charges or restrict access to services, no publication is required pursuant to WAC 480-100-194.
