The proposed extension of C-992 would allow ticketed passengers to be transported in either direction between Seattle and Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, Edmonds and Seattle-Tacoma International Airport.

State the conditions that demonstrate this proposed service is for the public convenience and necessity: The Dungeness Line (operated by Olympic Bus Lines under contract to WSDOT) is required to provide interlining service with Greyhound as a condition of the match required by the Federal Transit Administration to fund the service. The Greyhound computerized ticketing system recognizes all the stops in the Dungeness Line as destinations for which Greyhound passengers may be ticketed. Currently Certificate C-992 does not allow passengers for Dungeness Line to be picked up between Seattle and Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, Edmonds and Seattle, and Edmonds and Seattle Tacoma International Airport. Heckman Motors Inc. dba Olympic Bus Lines has Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration operating authority for this route per FMCSA Certificate MC-647853-C. (Attached)


