

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

- 5 (1) The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission is an agency of the State of Washington having authority to regulate household goods carriers as defined in RCW 81.80.
- 6 (2) Alice the Mover is a household goods carrier operating in Washington under permit THG-64915.
- 7 (3) On January 13, 2015, the Commission received notice of insurance cancellation related to Alice the Mover effective February 25, 2015. The Commission notified the Company that if a Form E insurance certificate was not received by the cancellation date, its permit would be cancelled.
- 8 (4) The Commission is authorized by WAC 480-15-450(1)(c) to cancel a household goods carrier's permit for failure to file and maintain proof of insurance.
- 9 (5) The Commission should cancel Alice the Mover's household goods carrier's permit for failure to file and maintain proof of insurance.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 10 (1) Permit THG-64915 held by Heidi Ann Bergman, d/b/a Alice the Mover, is cancelled as of February 25, 2015.
- 11 (2) Heidi Ann Bergman, d/b/a Alice the Mover, is directed to **cease** all operations associated with permit THG-64915.
- 12 (3) The application for permanent household goods authority in Docket TV-140064 is dismissed.
- 13 The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary, or to the Secretary's delegate, to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030, WAC 480-07-903(1)(c); and Order 04 in Docket A-090485.

The Commission will schedule your request for review by issuing a notice of hearing to be held before an administrative law judge. The Commission, at its discretion, may consider your request for review in an adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05 Part IV, or in a brief adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05.482 through .494. Following hearing, the administrative law judge will enter an initial order. If you wish to seek review of the initial order, you may file a petition for administrative review under RCW 34.05.464, or if the matter is heard in a brief adjudicative proceeding, under RCW 34.05.491.

The Commission will grant a late-filed request for review only on a showing of good cause, including a satisfactory explanation of why the person did not timely file the request. A form for late-filed requests is available on the Commission's Web site.

This notice and review process is pursuant to the provisions of RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-904(2) and (3), and WAC 480-07-905, as amended effective September 22, 2008.
