SpeediShuttle Washington, LLC hereby requests approval of the attached ticket agent agreements in accordance with WAC 480-30-391. The agreements meet all of the requirements of WAC 480-30-391. We request the agreements be effective May 1, 2015 as outlined in the enclosed Request for Less Than Statutory Notice.

The agreements have rates which are less than the maximum fare pursuant to WAC 480-30-420 contained in our flexible fare tariff No. 1. Each agreement contains the following as required by WAC-30-391:

- (a) The name and certificate number of the auto transportation company;
- (b) Identifying information about the person entering into the contract or agreement with the company. This information includes:
 - (i) Name;
 - (ii) Business address;
 - (iii) Business telephone number;
 - (iv) Business fax number;
 - (v) Business e-mail address;
- (c) The date on which the contract or agreement becomes valid and the date on which the contract or agreement will expire;
- (d) A clear description of the services that will be provided by the second party on behalf of the company;
- (e) A statement of the percentage of revenue or the set dollar amount that the company will pay the second party for performing those services; and
- (f) A statement as to how and when payment will be made to the company for tickets, less commission.
