

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

Dear Mr. Jones:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) received information from the Washington Department of Licensing (DOL) that Desert Wave is offering limousine and charter and excursion services. We understand that DOL staff provided you with our contact information.

The enclosed flyer explains the various licensing requirements for limousine, for hire and charter and excursion companies operating in Washington. In order for Desert Wave to legally provide these types of transportation, your company must be properly licensed. For example, because you offer limousine services, you must obtain a limousine license from the Washington Department of Licensing. If you also offer passenger transportation over state lines, for example, between Washington and Idaho or Oregon, you must register with Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration as an interstate passenger carrier.

Larger vehicles which seat more than 14 passengers, such as stretch Hummers or party buses, fall under our jurisdiction as charter buses. Therefore, any passenger transportation services you provide within Washington State in these vehicles require you to have authority from the commission.

Operating as a charter or excursion provider within Washington without the required certificate is illegal, is considered a gross misdemeanor, and is punishable as such (see RCW 81.70.220 and WAC 480-30-246, enclosed). Until and unless the commission grants your company the proper authority, you must cease providing charter and excursion services subject to commission regulation.

Licensing Requirements

Limousines/For Hire Vehicles/Charter & Excursion Carriers

Washington State regulates passenger transportation providers and vehicles to improve passenger safety, protect property, and ensure consistent service. This flyer provides the information and contacts that you will need in order to apply for the correct license to transport passengers within Washington State.

What license(s) do I need?

The kind of license you need depends primarily on the vehicle you use to provide transportation services. If you have vehicles of more than one type, you will need the proper licensing for each vehicle type you offer.

Limousine Licensing

To offer limousine services, you need to be licensed as a Limousine Carrier.

- There are six types of vehicles that are considered limousines: stretch limousines, stretch sport utility vehicles, classic cars, and many models of sedans (such as Lincoln Town Car), sport utility vehicles, and vans. The Department of Licensing and Department of Revenue websites describe the specific limousine types.
- If a vehicle meets the definition of a limousine, and that vehicle is driven for compensation to the driver, the owner, or the company arranging the trip, the vehicle must be owned or operated by a limousine carrier that is licensed with the Department of Licensing. The vehicle must also be licensed by the Department as a limousine vehicle. Trips must be prearranged, which includes telling the customer the fare before the trip begins, and the driver (chauffeur) must be qualified and listed with the Department under their carrier's account.
- You must be a licensed limousine carrier in order to advertise limousine services and you must list your UBI number in the advertisement. No limousine carrier can advertise for hire services.

For Hire Licensing (including taxis)

If your vehicle is not a limousine and the wage or payment goes to the driver or vehicle owner, you are operating a for hire service. You must get a For Hire license for your business and a For Hire certificate for each vehicle.

For Hire vehicles do not include:

- Limousines
- School buses that are exclusively contracted to a school district
- Ride share (car pooling) vehicles
- Vehicles licensed under a Charter Party Carrier or Excursion Service Carrier (excursion vans, party buses, or buses)
- Non-profit transportation provided for certain persons and their attendants
- Courtesy transportation vehicles not being used for excursions

A For Hire company cannot use a limousine for wine tours unless it is also licensed as a Limousine Carrier.

Charter Party and Excursion Service Carrier Licensing (including party buses)

If you offer passenger transportation in a vehicle that is not a limousine and does not fall under for hire service, you may need a Charter Party or Excursion Service Carrier certificate from the Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC). These vehicles can include excursion vans, party buses and buses.

How do I get licensed?

Limousines and For Hire Vehicles (including taxis)

You will need to apply for:

- a business license (if you don't already have one),
- the appropriate limousine carrier or For Hire operator license, and
- a certificate for each vehicle you operate.

You will apply for Limousine and For Hire licenses and certificates through the Department of Revenue, but the Department of Licensing regulates the industry and approves the licenses. You can find specific licensing requirements on the Business Licensing Service website.

What if I transport passengers over state lines/international borders?

If you transport passengers between Washington and another state or into Canada, you must register with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) for interstate authority.

- a USDOT number (see FMCSA contact information below).

Are there consequences for not having the proper license(s)?

If you provide limousine, for hire or charter and excursion services without a license, you could be fined up to \$1,000 for each violation (or each day of illegal operation). Please make sure you get properly licensed!

RCW 81.70.220

Certificate or registration required.

(1) No person may engage in the business of a charter party carrier or excursion service carrier of persons over any public highway without first having obtained a certificate from the commission to do so or having registered as an interstate carrier.

(2) An auto transportation company carrying passengers for compensation over any public highway in this state between fixed termini or over a regular route that is not required to hold an auto transportation certificate because of a commission finding under RCW 81.68.015 must obtain a certificate under this chapter.

WAC 480-30-246

Sanctions for operating without a valid certificate.

(1) Operating without a certificate.

(a) If a representative of the commission or other law enforcement agency observes a company operating as a passenger transportation company without a certificate from the commission, that company is subject to a gross misdemeanor citation, for which the company must appear in court.

(b) If the commission receives information that a company is operating as a passenger transportation company without a certificate, and a commission representative or other law enforcement agency has not observed those operations, the commission may:

(i) Issue a citation through the court; or

(ii) Contact the company and provide education and technical assistance concerning applicable regulations. This includes giving the company a copy of the applicable laws, rules, and certificate application forms.

(c) If the company continues to operate without a certificate after commission education and technical assistance is offered, the commission may begin an administrative proceeding to classify the company as a regulated company under RCW 81.04.510. If, as a result of that proceeding, the commission formally classifies the company as an auto transportation company or a charter and excursion carrier operating without the required certificate, the commission will issue a cease and desist order under RCW 81.04.510.

(d) If a company operates in violation of a commission order, the commission may impose penalties and/or take legal action in court.

(2) **Operating while certificate is suspended.** A company that operates after the commission suspends the company's certificate is subject to:

(a) Misdemeanor or gross misdemeanor citations, for which the company must appear in district court;

(b) Monetary penalty assessments or other commission administrative actions; or

(c) Commission proceedings to cancel the company's certificate.

(3) **Operating after certificate is canceled.** A company that continues to operate after the commission cancels the company's certificate is subject to:

(a) Misdemeanor or gross misdemeanor citations, for which the company must appear in district court; and

(b) Enforcement proceedings in superior court.
