**RE: Electric Schedule No. 139 - Voluntary Long Term Renewable Energy
Advice No. 2016-35 – Electric Tariff Filing**

Dear Mr. King:

Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060, WAC 480-80-101 and -105, please find enclosed for filing the following proposed revisions to the WN U-60, Tariff G for electric service of Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”):

1st Revision of Sheet No. 139-E – Schedule No. 139 Voluntary Long Term Renewable Energy (Continued)

The purpose of this filing is to reduce the Schedule 139 Energy Charge Credit subsequent to PSE’s power cost update filing of Schedule 95, Power Cost Adjustment Clause in Docket No. UE-161135. This revision is provided for in Section 8 of Schedule 139 which states, “The Energy Charge Credit will be updated with each general rate case, power cost only rate case, or other power-related filings.”

The tariff sheet described herein reflects an issue date of December 2, 2016, and an effective date of January 3, 2017. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by law and the Commission’s rules and regulations, is being completed immediately prior to or coincident with the date of this transmittal letter through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-100-193.

The proposed reduction to the Energy Charge Credit is an increase to Schedule 139 charges and WAC 480-100-194 requires publication of proposed tariff changes which increase charges. PSE is currently processing Enrollment Requests and this filing predates any Customer having entered into a Service Agreement with PSE. Therefore, PSE will provide notice in accordance with WAC 480-100-193, in the manner stated above.
