

Q: As part of the filing could you also supply a simple drawing of your current water system, the line extension and the Palmers water system. Please show the approximate length of the line extension. Also, do you have an estimate of the line extension costs?

A: Please see attachment "Palmer Lane Improvements" for the drawing, which includes the part of our system that they will be connecting into. We believe the bid price is between \$170,000-\$180,000 – they've contracted a 3rd party to do the work.

Q: In paragraph number 5, a statement about transfer of LE by Bill of Sale. Is this for the line extension, the Palmers water system or both?

Also since you are providing water to Palmers water system , what is the status of the Palmers well and supply?

If the line extension and water system are transferred, we will need some record of historical cost for both.

A: This will transfer their new water main and the easements that go along with it. The existing wells and old infrastructure are being completely removed from operation. The new extension will be transferred to LEI – historical cost is unknown at this time since it hasn't been put in yet.

Q: In paragraph 7, 8, and 9 there is reference to UTC tariff. Are the customers of Palmers becoming customers of LE through the WB Waterworks tariff?

If the Palmers members are becoming part of WB Waterworks have they been given notice of the tariff and the Commission?

A: Palmers customers will become customers of LEI, therefore under the WB Waterworks tariff, which is stated in the contract. They have been notified verbally by their president at their meetings. They will be officially notified from us with a mailed 30-day notice, once we have a set date that the water will be turned on. This notice will also be sent to Consumer Affairs.
