

Passenger rules page 1, 1st revised page 1

- 1- Island Airporter LLC reserves the right to refuse service to anyone an Island Airporter LLC employee believes would create an unsafe or unpleasant trip for the other passengers or themselves.
- 2- Passengers are required to wear clothing, which reasonably covers themselves along with footwear.
- 3- Passengers who have been drinking or who are suspected of having drunk excessively or having used or are using drugs, will not be allowed to board.
- 4- No consumption of Alcohol or drugs permitted on the Bus.
- 5- Service animals, as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act, will be carried free of charge. Service animals may not occupy passenger seats unless it is necessary to assist an individual with a disability.
- 6- No weapons may be transported in the passenger compartment of the Bus. All weapons must be claimed and unloaded then loaded into the luggage compartment for transport.
- 7- Children under the age of 16 are only allowed to travel alone with permission slip from the legal guardians.
- 8- Carrier will not be liable for delays caused by accidents, break downs, bad conditions of roads, delays by the Washington State Ferry System, snow storms or other conditions beyond the control of the carrier and does not guarantee arrival at, or departure from, any point at any specific time. The time schedules provided are schedules the carrier endeavors to maintain, but does not guarantee to be able to do so at all times due to conditions listed above.
