City Sanitary, Joe's Refuse, White Pass Garbage.

Dear Mr. King:

Attached please find revised pages for Tariff Number 9.3, as well as supporting  
documentation for the commodity credit adjustment. Tariff pages 1, 23, 25, 28 and 29  
are affected by this change.

In area RSA-1 the residential and multi-family credit will increase from \$0.36 to \$1.59,  
an increase of \$1.23 (342%) per customer, per month. In Thurston County Below  
142<sup>nd</sup> the residential credit will increase from \$0.21 to \$1.70, an increase of \$1.49  
(710%) per customer, per month. The multi-family credit will increase from \$0.23 to  
\$1.72, an increase of \$1.49 (648%) per customer, per month. City Sanitary, Joe's  
Refuse, White Pass Garbage do not currently participate in any county revenue share  
program.

If approved, by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, the revised  
commodity credits will go into effect on July 1, 2017. The customers will receive  
notification of this change on the first billing reflecting the change.
