
Event Description:

On June 1, 2017, Ashley N. Guthrie was struck and fatally injured by a southbound BNSF freight train at milepost 122.8, on the mainline in Ellensburg, WA. Kittitas County Sheriffs Office investigated the incident. When they arrived, they found the train stopped on the main track in the area of Stone Road and Woodhouse Loop. The locomotive engineer stated he was traveling southbound when he observed something lying along the side of the tracks. The train horn was sounded in an attempt to alert the unidentifed object. The engineer noticed that the object was a female and stirred and sat up facing the train. The brakes where immediately applied and the horn continued to sound. He stated that the cattle guard struck the individual. It was reported by the Washington State Patrol Toxicology Laboratory that drugs were detected in the lab results.

Site Description:

This portion of track runs west to east from Ellensburg to Yakima. There is approximately one mile of sight distance in both directions. There are no "No Trespassing" signs in the area. A two lane road runs parallel to the train tracks. There is a crossing at Ringer Loop Road, about two-tenths of a mile east of where the individual was struck. This is a rural area, with no public access to the track.

On the metal frame behind the stairs, I located a tread mark from a shoe which matched the loafers located by the deceased. I took photographs to document.

Deputy Nielsen told me that the conductor, Richard Barber, had stated that they had been in the front engine of the train travelling at about 40 mph and they were sounding the horn as they approached the Ringer Loop railroad crossing. Barber had stated that they observed the female suddenly sit up on the tracks. Barber advised that the female had appeared to have been lying on the east edge of the railroad ties and it looked like she was trying to get up and move away from the train.

I advised the coroner of my findings when he arrived and he requested Steward and Williams respond. Once Steward and Williams responded and retrieved the deceased, Deputy Nielsen, Deputy Whitsett, Deputy Vraves and I searched along both sides of the train and were unable to locate any items of evidentiary value.

This concludes my involvement in the case.




