**Item 100 – Residential Service – Monthly Rates (continued from previous page)**

Note 1: Customers will be charged for service requested even if fewer units are picked up on a particular trip. No credit will be given for partially filled cans. No credit will be given if customer fails to set receptacles out for collection.

Note 2: For service more frequently than weekly, multiply the above rates by the number of times per week service is required.

Note 3: The charge for an occasional extra residential bag, can, cart, unit, mini-can, or micro-mini can on a regular pickup is:

Garbage Collection	32-gallon can or unit	<b>\$ 3.29</b>
Yard Waste Collection	32-gallon can or unit	<b>\$ 2.50</b>

Note 4: A re-delivery fee of **\$15.85** will be assessed to cart customers whose service is discontinued for non-payment, or who request re-delivery due to customer initiated temporary suspension of subscribed services. In addition, customers will be assessed the re-start fee of **\$16.25** reflected in Note 6 below.

Note 5: In accordance with Douglas County Solid Waste Collection Fee Ordinance C.E. 94-014, the fee shown in Column 3 on page 22 will be assessed each month. This fee will expire on **March 31, 2018**.

Note 6: A re-start fee of **\$16.25** will be assessed when customers who request a temporary suspension of service for a period of less than one month.

Note 7: For those customers who do not receive garbage service add **\$1.40** to the recycling and/or yard waste rates shown on page 21 and 22.

Note 8: Regularly scheduled yard waste customers who request an additional 96-gallon cart will be assessed a monthly fee of **\$ 4.25** for each additional cart requested.

Note 9: Effective September 1, 2017 can service will no longer be available to new customers. Existing can customers may continue to use their cans at the applicable tariff rates until such time that they choose to change their service. At such time, can customers will be required to subscribe for cart services provided for in the tariff. (N)

Note 2: In accordance with Douglas County Solid Waste Collection Fee Ordinance C.E. 94-014, a fee of **\$0.22** per can per pick up will be added to the fees shown above for customers residing in Unincorporated Douglas County. This fee will expire on **March 31, 2018**.

Note 3: Effective September 1, 2017 can service will no longer be available to new customers. Existing can customers may continue to use their cans at the applicable tariff rates until such time that they choose to change their service. At such time, can customers will be required to subscribe for cart services provided for in the tariff. (N)
