

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the meeting was adjourned.



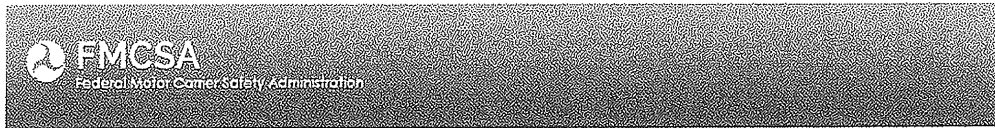

REGULAR FARES: Adult fares apply to passengers who have reached or passed their sixteenth birthday. Children under sixteen years of age will be charged the youth rate regardless of whether they occupy a seat or not. A child/infant restraint system is highly recommended for all children under 8 years old. The company does not provide child/infant seats, and the driver cannot assist with securing the seat.

INTERMEDIATE APPLICATION: Fares to or from intermediate points not named herein, will be the same as the fare to or from the next more distant station for which fares are named.

TICKET LIMITATION: One-way tickets will be good for 3 months from the date of sale. Round-trip tickets will be good for 3 months from the date of sale.

TICKET REDEMPTION: Unused tickets will be redeemed at the purchase price and unused portions of round-trip or commutation tickets will be redeemed by charging the regular fare or fares for the portion or portions used, and refunding the balance of the purchase price. A customer who has made a reservation but fails to cancel, reschedule, or appear at the designated pick-up point by the scheduled departure time is not eligible for a refund unless the failure was caused by an airline delay or cancellation.

RESERVATIONS: Advance reservations are recommended two days prior to departure date. Passengers may board without reservations if space is available.

INTERLINE AGREEMENT: Olympic Bus Lines has an interline agreement with Greyhound Bus Lines. Greyhound Bus Lines will receive 10% of the one-way or round-trip ticket price charged by Olympic Bus Lines on any passengers booked by Greyhound to Port Angeles or Sequim or points along the route of Olympic Bus Lines and 10% of the one-way or round-trip ticket price charged by Olympic Bus Lines on any passengers through ticketed on Greyhound booked by Olympic Bus Lines for the Port Angeles to Seattle or points along the route service.
