



Narrative:

On 8/4/17 at approximately 1658 hours I was dispatched to a train VS pedestrian collision just south of Tenino on Bucoda Hwy. The incident was originally dispatched to Tenino PD, until they arrived on scene and observed it was in the county. Tenino PD also advised the person was deceased.

While enroute to the location Lt. Ziesemer advised a detective was also being dispatched to the location.

I arrived on scene and contacted Sgt Weiss and a Burlington Northern Railway Police Officer. Sgt Weiss secured the scene as I contacted the engineer and the conductor who were still in the train's engine car.

I contacted Matthew Abraham who is the train's conductor. Matthew advised he was sitting in the engine car on the left side as the train came out of town. According to Matthew he was the first to see an object on the track. Matthew asked the engineer what it was but neither was able to indentify as they were still a ways out. As the train continued down the track Matthew blew the train horn several times but he could still not tell what it was and there was no movement. Matthew explained they were still over a 1/4 mile away from the person when the person started to move. Matthew continued to blow the horn.

Matthew explained the person was moving very slowly and it was around then when the engineer engaged the emergency brake. The train continued to slow as the person was slowly getting up. Matthew said the person was almost up when they turned around and reached for something that was sitting on the track by their side.

I asked Matthew if it appeared the male had jumped in front of the train and Matthew said "no". The person seamed to wait till the last minute to get up and was moving very slowly as if they were intoxicated. As they passed the person the engineer was able to observe the male being thrown to the side.

I then spoke to the engineer, Kaldin (Kevin) Ball. Kevin said they had just come out of town and he was slowing down as his light was flashing yellow. Kevin went onto say the conductor was the first to see the person on the road but they did not know what it was then. Kevin said as they traveled south he started to slow even more as the object was not moving even though the conductor was sounding the horn.

According to Kevin as they approached they could see the person was starting to move but at a very slow rate. Kevin then activated the emergency brake. The train started to slow but the person was still on the tracks. Kevin also explained the person did get up but then reached back down for something just as the train approached him. Kevin then looked in the side mirror and observed the person being thrown to the side. Kevin also stated the male was moving as if he was intoxicated.

After the train stopped the conductor ran back and found the male as the engineer contacted their dispatch.

In speaking with the engineer and the conductor they both stated the male was sitting on the outside track with his feet out in front of him. The person made no movement until the last minute and when he did he moved very slow. They both explained the person was up but had reached back down toward the tracks and that was when he was struck.

The engineer and conductor stayed in the engine car for further contact with detectives.

In looking at the train it appeared contact was made with the front bottom step that protrudes out. There was fresh blood and tissue located on the bottom step.

In looking at the body it seemed the major injuries were to the head area. From the injuries seen it did not appear the person had been run over by the train.

In looking around the area where the male was located I observed a clothing items that appeared to be a sweatshirt, a water bottle, court document and printed directions to Texas from Tacoma, WA. The court documents located were in the deceased name filled out by a mental health professional seeking court ordered assistance with him.

I then secured the scene and waited for detectives.

Detective Oplinger arrived and the scene was released to him. (See his report for further.)

Forward to Detective Oplinger for follow up.
