Event Summary:


Mr. Mullins failed to stop while the train occupied the crossing at Hwy 6 on 7-15-2017. Mr. Mullins was traveling west on State route 6 at a high rate of speed and failed to slow down with the signal lights activated and the train occupying the crossing, Mr. Mullins struck the train and past away 13 days later due to his injuries.

Site Description:

The railroad crosses State Route 6 at a slight angle, the crossing has all the required signals and advance warning signage and road markings. The crossing signals are on a cantalever and no gates are installed at this crossing.

Recommendations:

Install crossing gates

Narrative: CC&C 15 Train vs/vehicle accident July 15, 2017

Four car passenger train being pulled by steam locomotive CC& 15, tender first, was headed east on the Curtis Branch. Upon approaching WA State Highway 6, crossing lights were flashing normally, engine bell was ringing, and engine whistle was blowing. Upon coming into view of the road looking eastbound toward Adna, engineer observed vehicle heading westbound at high rate of speed. Vehicle did not appear to be slowing and so engineer "dumped the train". Vehicle then hit the brakes and tried to swerve to the right but it was too late and vehicle hit the back engineer side of the tender. By the time the train stopped the vehicle had caused five (5) FRA defects to the engine and first passenger car and various other damage. Once cleared by authorities, the train was taken to the nearest repair facility and the affected equipment was taken out of service until repairs were completed. The re-railer that normally hangs on the side of the tender, toward the back, was found lying on the road on the center line.



An 82-year-old driver hit by a train in Lewis County earlier this month has died, according to Washington State Patrol.

Jerry W. Mullins of Curtis was driving east on state Route 6 near Twin Oaks Road when he apparently failed to see warning lights that a train was approaching. He was hit by the Chehalis No. 15, a Baldwin locomotive operated by the Chehalis-Centralia Railroad & Museum.

The crash occurred at about 6:45 p.m. July 15.

According to WSP, Mullins was taken to Providence Centralia Hospital and later transported to Harborview Medical Center in Seattle, where he died.

On 07/15/2017 I was advised that Trooper Sills (1216) was responding to a vehicle vs train collision with the roadway blocked on State Route 6 near Twin Oaks Rd. I responded to the scene to assist Trooper Sills.

Upon arrival, I observed a steam train blocking State Route 6, and a pickup truck with severe damage near the train. Medical staff were working with the driver of the vehicle, who was still inside. At the time, the driver was alert and conscious, and was not complaining of serious injuries. I contacted the conductor of the train. The conductor stated that they were crossing the State Route 6 when they were hit by the truck. The conductor stated he had been using his horn as required, and the lights at the railroad crossing were functioning. The lights at the railroad crossing were still functioning while I was at the scene.

The driver of the pickup truck was removed from the vehicle by medical staff and transported to the hospital. I photographed the scene, and provided the photographs to Trooper Sills. This concludes my involvement in the investigation.
