Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) has determined that your company has failed to comply with regulatory reporting requirements and/or failed to pay required regulatory fees.

^{*}Company with dual authority: Auto Transportation and Charter and Excursion authority. Pacific Northwest Distributing, LLC, has not submitted the 2017 charter and excursion regulatory fee. Beeline Tours LTD has not submitted a complete annual report or the 2017 auto transportation regulatory fee.

Under WAC 480-30-071, every auto transportation company must file an annual report and every charter or excursion company must file an annual safety report by May 1. In addition, under WAC 480-30-076, auto transportation companies and charter and excursion companies must pay regulatory fees each year by May 1.

WAC 480-30-171(2) provides that the Commission may cancel the certificate of an auto transportation carrier or a charter or excursion carrier if the carrier fails to file its annual report or pay required regulatory fees. Staff has determined that, as of the date of this notice, each of the companies listed above has not filed a complete annual report and/or paid the regulatory fees that were due by May 1, 2017.

The Commission, therefore, intends to cancel your company's certificate.

To avoid cancellation of your certificate, you must take one of the following two actions **within 30 days** of the date of this notice:

- (1) Come into compliance with applicable law by submitting the delinquent annual report (auto transportation) or annual safety report (charter and excursion) and paying the required regulatory fee (annual report forms as well as information on how to make a payment are available on the Commission's website: www.utc.wa.gov); or
- (2) Request a hearing to demonstrate why your certificate should not be canceled. All hearing requests must comply with the Commission's procedural rules, contained in WAC 480-07, which are available on the Commission's website on its <u>Legal Research Tools</u> page.

If you do not respond to this notice within 30 days of the service date of this notice by complying with the regulatory requirements or by requesting a hearing, the Commission will enter an order canceling your certificate without further notice. Companies without the required passenger carrier certificate from the Commission are prohibited from providing auto transportation and charter and excursion services in the state of Washington.
