Re: Advice No. 2017-12 – Natural Gas Tariff Filing – Filed Electronically

Dear Mr. King:

Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and Chapter 480-80 WAC, please find enclosed for filing the following proposed revisions to the WN U-2 Tariff for natural gas service of Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”):

- 13th Revision of Sheet No. 1129 - Low Income Program
- 9th Revision of Sheet No. 1129-A - Low Income Program (Continued)
- 16th Revision of Sheet No. 1129-B - Low Income Program (Continued)

The purpose of this filing is to adjust and true-up the low income rates as provided in (1) Exhibit G to the Settlement Stipulation Agreement approved by the Commission in consolidated Docket Nos. UE-011570 and UG-011571, (2) the Multiparty Settlement Stipulation in Docket No. U-072375 and the Partial Settlement in consolidated Docket Nos. UE-072300 and UG-072301, (3) the Commission Order 08 in consolidated Docket Nos. UE-111048 and UG-111049, and (4) the Commission Order 07 in consolidated Docket Nos. UE-121697 and UG-121705 and consolidated Docket Nos. UE-130137 and UG-130138.

The amount of change in the total natural gas Schedule 129-Low Income Program revenue requirement over last program year is a decrease of \$1,005,004. This revenue requirement results in an approximate average overall decrease to rates for natural gas customers of 0.13%. Details supporting the revised level of funding, prior year collections and rate calculations are detailed in work papers that will be provided directly to the Commission’s staff.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect issue dates of August 31, 2017, and effective dates of October 1, 2017. Posting of the proposed tariff change for public inspection and review, as required by law and the Commission’s rules and regulations, is being completed immediately prior to or coincident with the date of this transmittal letter on the PSE website, in accordance with WAC 480-90-193. Notice to the public under the provisions of WAC 480-90-194 is not required, however

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PSE will provide, as part of the electric Schedule 129-Low Income Program tariff filing, within 30 days of the requested October 1, 2017, effective date.
