As they crossed WHEELER and RUFF saw what they believed to be garbage between the rails for the track they were on. It wasn tuntil they were upon the object that they realized it was a man seated on a5-gallon bucket. He appeared to be hunched over with hishead cradled in hishands. He did not make any attempt to get off the rails. The train struck the victim. SFD responded and declared the victim DOA. Sqt Dunckle responded and requested TCIS respond. When detectives arrived the scene was turned over to them for processing. WHEELER and RUFF were provided business cards with the case number.1
