A female was on the Union Pacific Railroad tracks in the 100 block of H St NW, was struck by a train and died from her injuries.%

On 5/12/18 at 06:03hrs APD Officer were dispatched to a train/pedestrian collision on the Union Pacific Railroad tracks near 2nd St NW and H St NW. An employee for the railroad was calling it in and saying that it was believed that the pedestrian was deceased.

The first arriving officers at 06:06hrs found the subject in the 100 block of H St NW. The subject was female and her body was on the gravel about 10ft west of the tracks, below track grade. She was lying on her back, head towards the tracks. The female had on camouflage pants, and a gray shirt and black sweatshirt that was pulled up above her chest and her feet were bare. The female had obvious external injuries.

I arrived at 06:10hrs and walked up to the body. I could see that the train had been traveling north on the tracks and was now stopped north of our location. The back of the train looked to be about 4 blocks north of and the front of the train looked to be in the 1300 block area. VFRA personnel arrived and confirmed that the female was deceased.

Officer Acito told me that he recognized the female as Ashley Grover. He said that graveyard patrol officers had contacted her a couple of times in the area, earlier in the morning. At this time the train crew had walked down to where we were. The crew was identified as Conductor Joshua Long and Engineer in training, Daniel Johnson. I asked Long what he had seen. He told me that the female had been on the tracks, standing right next to the left rail and she had her back to the train. Long said they saw her some distance back and were on their air horn constantly up to the point of impact. Long said it did not appear the female gave any indication that she heard the horn. Long said the train had been traveling at 50mph. UPRR Police Officer R. Newton arrived at this time.

After examining the body and taking photographs, I walked the tracks south. Between the body and the W Main St crossing, I found a pair of black sandals lying on the rocks directly next to the tracks on the west side. After taking photographs of the area I used a rolling tape measure to measure the scene. From W Main St north to where the sandals were was 116ft. From the sandals to the body was 104ft.

Officer Powell assisted and responded to the front of the train. The lead engine was engine #UP8121. Officer Powell said he found a small amount of flesh on the left side of the plow, and dark colored hair on the upper section of the front step hand rail. Officer Powell took photos of this as well as overall photos of the engine.

I then contacted the King County Medical Examiner to have them respond. While waiting from them to respond I looked at the graveyard patrol officers contacts with the female Ashley Grover. I saw that at 03:24hrs, officers were dispatched to a welfare check on a female walking on railroad tracks and talking to herself in the 300 block of C St NW. These tracks are the Burlington Northern Railroad tracks. She was contacted by officers in the 100 block of C St NW and identified as Ashley Grover. The clothing description given was the same as what the deceased female was wearing. Officers Determined that Grover was able to care for herself and cleared from the contact.

At 10:16hrs, officers dispatched to welfare check in the 1000 block of W Main St. The call was of a female lying on the ground. The female was Ashley Grover. Officers made contact with her and believed that she was either impaired and or

had mental health issues. She was checked by VFRA and it was determined that she was not in any danger medically or in danger of harming herself. Ashley walked off from the contact on her own.

I then obtained a DOL photo of Ashley Grover. I could see from the photo of Grover that she was the deceased female. KCME Investigator Geerdes arrived at 07:09hrs. While completing his investigation, he looked the purse found on the body and inside the purse, folded up, was the birth certificate for Ashley Grover. After completing his investigation, Geerdes took possession of Grover's body and left the scene.

All photographs were downloaded to the department photo evidence drive. It is unknown why Ashley Grover was standing on the tracks with her back to the train. She was not wearing ear buds or headphones and should have heard the approaching train with its horn activated.
