NARRATIVE

On the listed date and time I responded to a suicide at the railroad crossing near Main St and Railroad Ave in Edmonds.

Multiple reporting parties called 911 advising that a female had been struck by a train. Multiple callers stated that it appeared to be an obvious suicide attempt, with a female intentionally lying down on the tracks just prior to the train crossing over Main St.

I arrived on scene with multiple other officers and saw a large crowd of people standing around a body, lying near the tracks, covered with what appeared to be a large beach towel.

I noticed that the cross bars were down, and the red lights and audible tone alerting of the train crossing were engaged.

Upon looking at the body, it was immediately clear that the female subject who'd been struck was obviously deceased. Her body was dismembered, with he head, one shoulder and one arm removed from her torso. These parts of her body had been drug/thrown by the impact at varying distances south from the apparent point of impact.

Multiple witnesses on scene provided written statements that were all consistent in explaining what had happened. The female reportedly made a run for the front of the train just prior to it crossing southbound over Main St. As she got to the track, she put her purse down, and then layed down across the tracks just moments before the train passed. The train hit/ran her over, and witnesses stated that she died instantly.

I located the decedent's purse and located a WA State ID card for Allison Waldron. Waldron's medical alert bracelet was also located on scene near the body. Cpl Crystal notified Waldron's next of kin, an aunt, Nostrand, of Waldron's death.

Multiple officers assisted in interviews and collecting statements. I requested the Medical Examiner respond to the scene. Prior to the ME's arrival, multiple supervisors and representatives from BNSF arrived on scene, along with one BNSF police officer, who conducted his own investigation.

I took photos of the scene and assisted in traffic/crowd control while awaiting the ME. Approximately 40 minutes later the ME arrived. At that point, the ME took over as primary investigator, eventually taking custody of the body.

NARRATIVE

On 06/16/18 I responded to Main St and Railroad Ave to assist with a suicide scene. Dispatched advised that they had numerous reports of a female that had committed suicide by walking in front of a train.

Upon arriving on the west side of the tracks (accessed via Dayton St to Railroad due to train blocking at Main St), I observed a body lying just west of the train tracks in the center of Main St. The body was covered up by a colored beach towel. There were over 100 people in the area observing what was transpiring.

I contacted Ofc. Haughian, Ofc. Stanley, and Ofc. Dreyer. Ofc. Haughian said that he had several witnesses stated the female had set down her purse and laid down in front of the Southbound train just as it was reaching the north edge of Main St.

I turned to the crowd and asked if anyone else, who hadn't already been contacted by officers, had witnessed what happened. I had several subjects raise their hands. I obtained written statements and passed them out to the individuals and asked them to complete them and contact any one of the officers when done before they left the scene.

I then was contacted by fire personnel. They pointed out body parts of the female, later identified by her WA ID (in her purse) and Med Alert Bracelet (found on the tracks) as Alison Waldron, on and about the tracks, south of the point of impact.

I asked fire personnel if they could assist in helping get traffic off of the ferry and out of the area by way of Railroad to Dayton St. I had Ofc. Dreyer assist with traffic control on the east side of the tracks.

I then examined the scene. I observed Waldron's purse lying on the west side of the tracks, just north of the crosswalk. Slightly south of her purse on the tracks was blood smear (point of impact). As I moved South along the tracks, I observed small portions of Waldron's body (muscle, brains, etc). When I got to the south side of Main St, I observed her head, shoulder, and arm on the tracks beneath the train. Just south of that I observed her skull cap and a shoe on the tracks, beneath the train.

I remained on scene to assist Ofc. Haughian, as I had to release Ofc. Dreyer and Stanley to handle other calls for service.

I notified ACOP Lawless and Sgt. Hawley of the incident.

I also obtained Waldron's Lynnwood address (on her ID) from Ofc. Haughian. I contacted LPD Sgt. Correa and advised him of what had occurred. I asked if he could have an officer make contact at the residence. Sgt. Correa advised that he would respond himself. A short time later I received a call from Waldron's aunt. She said that the LPD officer was there and asked her to call me. I advised her of what had occurred. She broke down and was no longer able to talk with me. I asked Sgt. Correa to have a Chaplain respond to the house. I asked him to give the Chaplain my number if he needed anything.

I then remained on scene and worked with the ME and BNSF staff and police in collecting Waldron's remains. Once the ME was done, the fire department hosed down the scene in an attempted to wash away blood and any small pieces that had not been collected.

I then cleared the scene.

Case assigned on this date. I had previously learned of the case and read Officer Haughian's report.

06-22-18

I was advised that a male named Brandon (206-739-2199) called the Edmonds Police Department. He had seen the incident and wondered if he needed to do a statement.

I received a call from Suzy Knisley and spoke with her briefly. She stated that her husband is the decedent's father and that the decedent got into an argument with a man right before she laid down on the train tracks. Knisley asked who that male was. I advised her I was aware of the incident but had not received all of the written statement from the witnesses yet. Additionally, I was not aware of anyone that she was in an argument. I advised her I would review the case when I received a copy of the statements and then contact her if I needed to speak with her further.

06-25-18

I received a voicemail from Brian Pope. He stated that he knew the decedent and stated that the family had driven her to commit suicide based on the family situation and dynamic.

06-27-18

I reviewed the entire case including written statements from eleven people. One of them was from Victor Eskenazi who indicated that he knew the decedent. I earlier received a forwarded email from Sergeant McClure that Victor Eskenazi had more information about the incident. I reviewed his statement. His handwriting was difficult to read but it appeared that he may have had some contact with the decedent just before her death. I called Eskenazi and left a message requesting a return call.

I called Brian Pope and left a message requesting a return call. He called me a short time later. He told me that he knew the decedent from church and that she lived with her aunt. He stated that her aunt Nancy Nostrand had claimed that she had guardianship over Allison Waldron but it was later discovered that she actually did not have guardianship. Several years ago Pope had tried to convince Waldron to leave Nostrand's house because she was being emotionally abused. Nostrand refused to allow this. The police were called and according to Pope stated that they could not do anything. He also stated that APS was called and they also stated that they couldn't do anything. Pope stated that Waldron was planning on moving out on her own but had not told her aunt yet. I asked why Nostrand might have guardianship. Pope stated that Waldron had seizures but didn't know anything more about them. I asked if she was intellectually disabled. He said she was not. I thanked him for the information and told him that there didn't appear to be a crime but that he was not the only person to call with concerns.

I received a message from Victor Eskenazi. Eskenazi stated in his message that he does not answer his phone when people call him but checks messages and then calls people back. I called him back and left a message requesting a return call.

Victor Eskenazi called me and we scheduled a time for him to come in to meet with me at the Edmonds Police Department on 7/9 at 1000 hours.

07-09-18

Eskenazi came into the Edmonds Police Department at approximately 1000 hours. He stated that he was walking into Brackett's Landing and saw the decedent sitting on a bench using a fidget spinner. He stated he did not know her and had never met her before. He saw that she was anxious and nervous and struck up a conversation with her and she began talking about domestic abuse and that her aunt was her legal guardian because of brain injury that she suffered when she was three years old. She told him that she was abandoned by her father and was left with her alcoholic mother. She mentioned that she had an appointment with her counselor the following Wednesday. She stated that she was afraid to go home but didn't know where to go.

After 10-20 minutes of speaking with her a train whistle blew. She said something to Eskenazi about "my train" and stood up. She was very animated and began walking south and then toward the railroad tracks. Eskenazi thought she was just going to run across the tracks but she then went down to her knees and laid down on the railroad tracks and then struck by the train.

Eskenazi was told by a Ferry employee that the decedent was there earlier asking about a train that didn't stop. Eskenazi went to a vigil for the decedent the previous weekend and spoke with one of her cousins who told I'm that she visited a family member in the hospital prior to being dropped off in Edmonds. She had told her family that she was going to Edmonds to see a friend. Eskenazi stated that the decedent had told him that she lied to her family that she was going to Edmonds to see a friend because she didn't want to go home. Eskenazi stated that he didn't see anyone with her.

I received a voicemail from Suzy Knisley. Knisley had called to follow up about concerns that she had previously told me about regarding emotional abuse by Nancy Nostrand to Allison Waldron. I explained that emotional abuse was not necessarily criminal and that even if there was physical abuse, with Waldron now deceased there was no way to prove it. Knisely indicated that Nostrand had another niece living with her and was being emotionally abusive to her too. I recommended that she report that to Adult Protective Services. She also told me about other family members that she believed were trying to commit disability fraud. I referred her to the Washington State Department of Social and Health Service and/or United States Social Security Administration.
