

On 07/07/18, at approximately 1914 hrs, I was dispatched to a train vs. pedestrian collision at Central Ave N and E James St, City of Kent, County of King, State of Washington. Dispatch advised that the caller was reporting that a train had hit a pedestrian. The female pedestrian was reported to be laying on the side of the tracks.

I arrived onscene and located the female on the east side of the train tracks approximately 40 yards south of E James St. I could see blood around her face, left arm and the left side of her torso. She was unresponsive to verbal or physical stimulus, I was unable to detect radial or carotid pulse and did not see her chest rising. I performed chest compressions and was relieved by Officer JD. Johnson. I cut the female's shirt and bra and assisted with placing AED pads on the female. The AED advised of a "No shock" command and CPR was resumed.

Puget Sound Fire personnel and King County Medics arrived onscene and took over life-saving efforts. She was pronounced as deceased shortly after.

There were multiple personal items scattered around the female one of which was a Kent Police business card with case number #18-10094 written on it. A check of that report listed Taryle Stalter as a theft victim. Photos of Stalter were located in DOL and Law Enforcement databases and she appeared to match the deceased female.

I took photos of the body and the scene around it and later uploaded them into Veripic.

I contacted WIT 1/ Asia Smith. She told me that she was parked in the left westbound lane just east of the tracks. She said that there was 1 car in front of her and that the railroad arms were down and the bells were chiming. She said that the female was somewhere in the eastbound lanes and was sitting or crouched down before she was struck by the train. Smith said that she was stopped in the roadway for approximately 30 seconds before the train entered the intersection. She said that there was a male subject riding a bicycle eastbound past the female. She said that the subject motioned to the female to move but continued riding. Smith described the male subject as Hispanic, early 30s, 5'8" to 5'10" and 180 lbs. He was wearing a sleeveless black shirt. She said that she last saw him at the corner of Railroad Ave N and E James St.

In the call log I saw that there were 2 witnesses that had called 911.

I called and spoke to WIT 3/ Alisha Mcgraw. She told me that she was in her car facing southbound on 1st Ave N at W James St. She said that she saw a person with long hair sitting on the tracks. Mcgraw said that the train had blown its horn as usual and that she saw the person jump out of the way moments before the train passed. She said that she believed that the person had avoided being hit by the train and added that the railroad arms were down, the red lights were flashing and that the bells ringing.

I called and spoke to WIT 4/ Corey Cross. He told me that he was driving eastbound in the right lane of E James St. He said that as he passed the tracks, he saw a woman. He said that she was facing northbound and was looking down. He said that as he passed, the barriers came down. He added that he could hear the bells ringing and could see the lights flashing. He added that as he looked back in his rearview mirror, he could see a male subject on a bike trying to pull the woman of the tracks.

Officer Melville spoke to the train conductor and handled the contact with the King County Medical Examiner's Office. See her report for further details.

struck by a train at 100 E James St in the city of Kent, county of King, state of Washington.

Upon arrival, I contacted the train conductor, WIT/James Griffith who told me the following:

Griffith is a train conductor for Burlington Northern. While traveling Southbound through Kent, he saw a male subject about 300 yards in front of him. The male was on a bike, heading Eastbound across the tracks at S James St. Griffith was only able to describe him as a "tan" male.

Griffith then saw, what he believed, was a jacket laying in the middle of the tracks. When he was about 150 yards away, he recognized that the jacket was actually a woman. Griffith activated all emergency braking equipment. He estimated the train was traveling at about 40 mph when it struck the woman.

I provided Griffith with this case number and my contact information.

After I was done speaking with Griffith, I was approached by a Medic One paramedic who advised me the woman was deceased (1930 hours). I contacted the King County Medical Examiner. Forensic Medicolegal Death Investigator, WIT/Alison Myrabo, later arrived. She provided me with a KCME case number (18-1378) and took custody of the body.

I assisted Alison in collecting the victim's various belongings which had been strewn along the tracks. Alison took belongings of value or sentiment into her custody. I agreed to take the damaged items which were later destroyed by me.

I provided Alison with this case number and my contact information.

This ends my involvement in this case.

The victim was later tentatively identified as Taryle Stalter via a WA Department of Licensing photograph. I took various photographs of the scene and of Stalter. Those photographs were later entered into VERIPIC. I was then cleared from the scene by Sqt. Mills.

On 07-07-18, I responded near the intersection of Central Ave. N. and James St. for the report of a train striking a pedestrian. The female was reported laying next to the train. Upon arrival with additional KPD Officers, the female was located on the east side of the train tracks.

Officers Moreno, J. Johnson and I began chest compressions on the unresponsive female who had a very slight pulse. The female was wearing a large cast on her right leg. A KPD defribulator was administered to the female and did not recommend a shock. I observed her personal belongings, including a green backpack, strewn across the east side of the train tracks. King County Medics arrived and took over medical procedures.

I photographed the scene and female (VERIPIC). I contacted the engineer, (WIT) Brent Wendtland, who was operating the train at the moment of the collision. He observed pedestrian traffic crossing the tracks and began his first horn sequence to alert them approximately 200-300 feet away. Wendtland watched a bicyclist cross the tracks eastbound. He observed a green backpack laying on the east side of the tracks' concrete section. The back pack was on the James St. crossing of the train tracks.

Wendtland was startled to observe the backpack stand up and a female wearing it. At speeds approximately 45 MPH, Wendtland had no time to stop and the train engine struck the female who was struggling to move out of the train's path. He did not believe the male bicyclist was a companion of the female. Wendtland could not provide a description of the male cyclist and did not describe a suspicious circumstance surrounding the incident.

I photographed the engine and engine plow which had a pair of headphones wedged inside it along with human matter (VERIPIC). Wendtland believed the female was carrying headphones in her hand at the moment of impact.
