Re: Avista Voluntary Solar Select Program Tariff Schedule 87 Revision

Dear Mr. Johnson,

On February 2, 2018, Avista Corporation, dba Avista Utilities (Avista or the Company), filed proposed tariff Schedule 87, "Voluntary Solar Select Program", applicable to large commercial and industrial customers. During the March 29, 2018 Open Meeting, the Commission took no action on the Company's proposed tariff filing, thus letting the tariff go into effect by operation of law with an effective date of April 2, 2018. As requested by Commission Staff, the Company agreed to the following commitment after tariff Schedule 87 was in effect:

Following the conclusion of Avista's general rate case, Docket UE-170485, the Company will update its tariff Schedule 87, and supporting work papers, to reflect any changes to its cost of capital and cost of service data, which were used to calculate the Solar Resource Rates, Solar Resource Credits, and Renewable Generation Incentives specified in Schedule 87.

On April 26, 2018, the Commission issued Order 07 in Docket UE-170485, resolving Avista's 2017 general rate case. The outcome of the general rate case had minimal impacts on the

cost components of the Solar Select Program. On May 11, 2018, the Company filed to update its tariff Schedule 87 to reflect the values shown in the table below. The tariff became effective by operation of law on June 11, 2018.

The Company just became aware that it inadvertently included in incorrect value for the revised Renewable Generation Incentive for rate Schedule 31 in tariff Schedule 87. It included the average of the three rate schedules in the tariff, rather than the individual incentive for Schedule 31. As such, the purpose of this housekeeping filing is to update tariff Schedule 87B to include the correct Renewable Generation Incentive for rate Schedule 31, highlighted in the table below:
