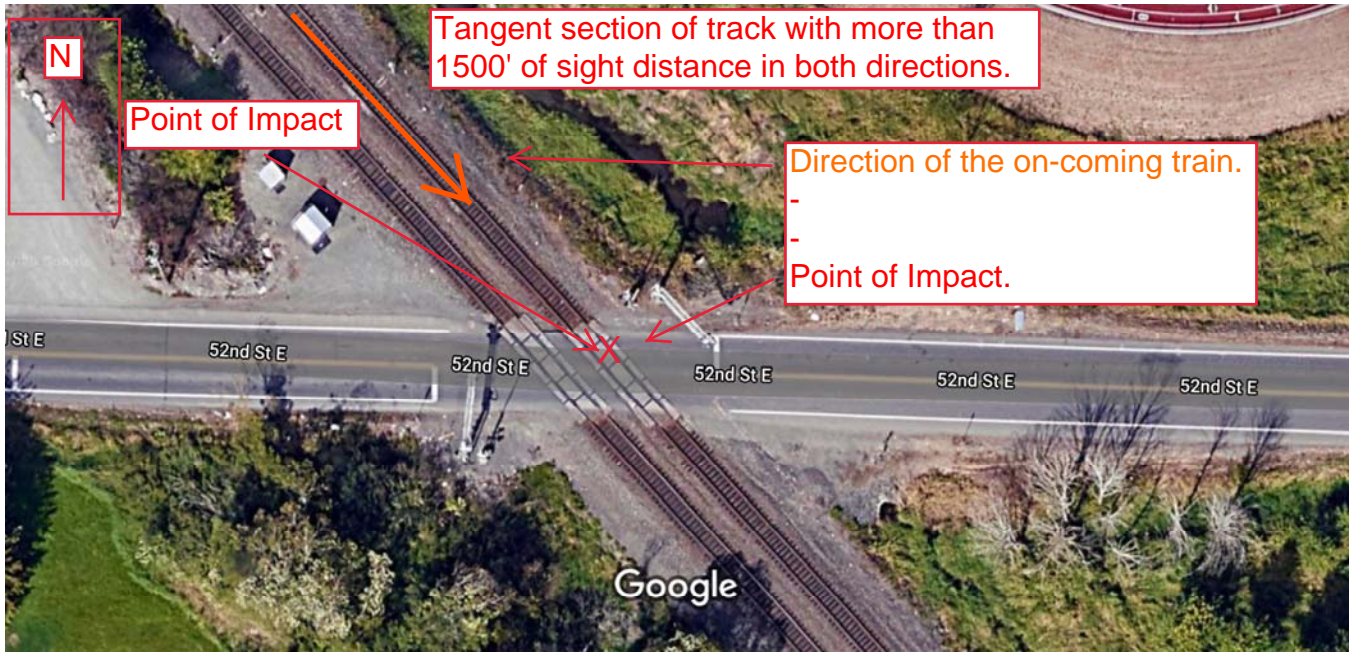

Narrative: On 10-31-2018, at 1350 hrs, I responded to 5400 52nd ST E, as requested by SS911 regarding this death investigation. I arrived at 1400 hrs. Upon my arrival I established contact with Deputy Denato 337, who further explained this incident to me. Detective Eldridge 228 arrived a short time later.

The scene is a train (cargo) "vs" pedestrian incident located at the roadway crossing. The train is reported to have made contact with the decedent at the railroad crossing. This crossing is marked with lights and barriers. The decedent is reported to have been struck and flown approximately 50ft. The decedent was found along the shoulder of the southbound track. The decedent was transported by EMS to a local hospital.

I found a grey colored sneaker near the location where the decedent is reported to have been found. I further observed apparent blood in the aggregate rock along the southbound shoulder of the tracks.

I observed the front of the leading engine. The lower push guard of the engine reveals an apparent strike mark at the lower right corner of the push guard. This strike appears to be a fresh swipe mark removing the thin layer of dirt on the guard.

I collected the sneaker as evidence. At 1505 hrs I cleared the scene and transported the evidence back to the Forensics Lab for safe keeping.

I exposed multiple digital images of the scene using the Nikon D3300 equipped with the Nikkor AF-S DX 18-55mm lens. Image quality is set to Programmed Auto and Fine JPEG compression. The built in flash was utilized as needed depending on ambient light availability. The images are captured on a four gigabyte (4GB) memory card.

I cleared at 1535 hrs...

On 11-01-2018, I inventoried the sneaker under report ECT (.3). I submitted the sneaker to the PCSD Property room.

I transferred the images off the memory card using Case Image Upload (2.0), to the LESA server.

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Narrative:	On 10-31-18 at about 1330 hours I responded to the 5200 block of Pioneer Way east in regards to a possible suicide. Upon arriving I spoke with Deputy Donato who advised me that the victim was found face
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down with the bottom half of his torso and feet facing up. The victim was transported to Tacoma General Hospital.

I noted that the train was about ¼ mile past the stop at 52nd Street and Pioneer Way. The gates on both sides of the track were down and the red signal light was flashing. I spoke with the conductor Anthony Hougland. Anthony was visibly shaken. Anthony stated that he saw the victim approaching the train walk past the down gates, and then walk directly in front of the train. The victim made contact with the train on the west side. Anthony stated that he used the whistle several times to alert the victim with no response. Anthony stated that he applied the brakes but there was no way to avoid the victim.

I spoke with the engineer Quinn Yarger. Quinn stated that there speed was between 39-40 mph. The emergency brake was applied and then the strike. Quinn advised also that the whistle was blown multiple times.

I observed that there were scuff marks where the dirt had been wiped away from the west front side of the train. I walked back to the gate and saw an impact mark where the victim had glanced off the train and landed beside the train tracks. A gray high top tennis shoe was located where the victim was discovered.

I walked the road to look for a possible homeless camp or a wallet to identify the victim. I was not able to find any identification or a homeless camp in that vicinity. I was advised that the victim was deceased at Tacoma General Hospital and they did not find any identification on his person. I talked with the Medical Examiner's office by phone and was advised that they would send someone to pick up the deceased in the evening. I made contact with Tacoma General and was advised that the deceased was moved to the hospitals morgue.

It appears that the victim was intent on committing suicide. He has not been identified at this time. I spoke with Special Agent Brecht who works for BNSF. He advised me that there are camera's located on the front of the train and that he would obtain any video he could of the incident.

At about 1915 hours I spoke with (W) Nicole Corak. Nicole advised me that she was the first car in line at the train crossing. Nicole stated that the gates were down and the victim was standing on the tracks. Nicole stated that the train was blowing its horn and the victim did not move. Nicole stated that it was the track closer to the River Road side. Nicole stated that she saw the train make contact with the victim.

At about 1930 hours I saw that there was an annotation on the MDC that Rodney Hudnall who works for BNSF had located a piece of mail that may belong to the victim. Rodney stated that the paper has some information regarding a psychiatric evaluation. Rodney offered to email me the paper work. I looked at the paperwork which belonged to an eighteen year old male which did not fit the description of the victim.

At about 2030 hours I spoke with the medical examiner's office. I was advised that the victim was fingerprinted and that he was now identified as Ray Bernard Houston 2-6-1984. I ran a records check on Ray which showed that he had drug history but no reports of suicidal tendencies. Nothing Further at this time.
