




Photo showing fencing that restricts ability to use railroad property for direct passage

NARRATIVE

On the listed date and time, Officer Bryer and I responded to the area near 3rd Ave/Sunset Blvd to a report of a train vs pedestrian collision.

Upon arrival, we quickly located an unresponsive male victim underneath the train, just to the south of the Brown Bear Car Wash (1821 W Sunset Blvd). He was between the rails, with his head facing west. Several feet to the west of the victim was a large backpack. Fire personnel were directed to the area, and after it was confirmed that the train was stationary, they extracted the man from underneath the train. The decision was made to transport him to Sacred Heart Hospital where he was soon pronounced deceased.

I spoke with two witnesses who were operating the train at the time of the collision. Noel Wilton was the conductor, and Patrick Bleick was the engineer. Both men gave identical accounts of what occurred. The train was traveling westbound at a speed of about twenty-one miles per hour. Due to the fact that they were passing another train which was going the opposite direction, their forward-facing lights were dimmed as a courtesy. There was limited visibility to the front of the train. As the approached the area near 3rd/Sunset, they heard the distinct sound of two "thumps." Neither man was able to see anyone or anything on the tracks. Believing they had impacting something, perhaps a human, they stopped the train as soon as possible. They notified their communication center who then contacted police. Once the train came to a complete stop, the locomotive at the front of the train was immediately to the south of Coeur D' Alene Street, on the bridge. Patrick walked the tracks rearward until he located the male victim.

Cpl Baldwin took photographs at the scene. We maintained scene security until Major Crimes detectives arrived. Detectives assumed the investigation from that point on. See their reports for additional information.

I was wearing a body camera at the time of this incident and it was activated.

On 12-25-18 at about 1930 hours I responded to a possible train hitting a person on the tracks near 3rd and Sunset Blvd, behind the Brown Bear Car Wash. The train crew were out looking for a victim after they got the train stopped. They found the male on the tracks under the train behind the Brown Bear Car Wash. Other officers arrived first and radioed that medics were on scene and starting to work on the male who had been hit.

I arrived and started taking evidence pictures of the scene and the medics removing the male from under the train. Medics decided to transport to SHER based on the circumstances. I photographed the scene, and the front of the front engine. There was nothing that stood out as evidentiary value in the photos of the front scoop on the train. I did see a rub mark where possibly something could have rubbed dirt off of the top of the scoop/bumper on the left side as you faced it. Unknown if it was related or not.

I then responded to SHER to take photos of the male, who by that time had been pronounced deceased by ER staff. I photographed the injuries to the body, mainly a broken lower left leg/foot, and a large injury to the right side of his head.

I met with Det. Lebsock and Sgt. Bartlett with MCU and briefed the on what I had done and what I had seen. The scene and body were turned over to them.

During the evening of 12/25/2018 I received a phone call from Sgt. Bartlett. He advised an individual had been hit by a train and requested I respond to assist patrol with the investigation.

I responded to the scene and arrived at 8:35 PM. This location was on the Burlington Northern Santa Fe tracks immediately behind (to the south of) the business located at 1801 West Sunset Blvd. This was the location the decedent was found by the Union Pacific crew, between the tracks, under one of the train cars. The train cars were all enclosed and not of the type of cars that one could access the interior in which to ride.

In more detail as to this location, there is a Sunset Junction signal box that had been constructed on the north side of the tracks. There is a short set of concrete stairs with handrail that led up to the grade of the tracks and the signal box. These stairs ascend from north to south. I paced the location of where Poyner was located from the east side of this set of stairs. My pace is approximately 36 inches. There were 13 paces (approximately 39 feet) from the stairs to Poyner's recovery. Since Poyner had been transported prior to my arrival, I paced this distance from the stairs to a backpack, described further below. The tracks involved were those furthest to the north. It should be noted there is another set of tracks on the south side of these tracks that run basically parallel to those on the north.

I was briefed by Officers Conrath and Bryer. I was informed the person stuck was an adult male, and that this man's identity was not known at that time. The man struck had been transported to the hospital, where he was pronounced deceased. (Confirmation of the decedent's identity was made the following day after autopsy. He was 31 year old Ryan Earl Poyner.) I was further advised Corporal Baldwin had taken photos.

The train involved was a Union Pacific train. It had been travelling west on BNSF tracks. As I approached the scene of this incident I could not see the front or the rear of the train, due to the length of the train. As documented in the patrol report the locomotive of the front of the train was near Coeur D' Alene Street. This was approximately five blocks to the west of the location of where Poyner was located under one of the cars.

I retrieved the following items from under the train, between the tracks: a gray "Granite Gear" brand backpack, a silver colored eating fork within about three feet of the backpack, to the south (still between the tracks on which the train was setting); a blue piece of blanket that was about 8 feet to the east of the backpack, and a black knit stocking hat and one black "Carhartt" brand glove (left) approximately three feet south of the blanket. I also collected a pair of broken safety glasses that was next to these items - outside the rails to the south. The officers informed me these belonged to one of the medics who assisted with first aid efforts for Poyner.

There was an irregularly shaped pool of blood, about 10" X 12", on the rocks and a railroad tie, just to the west of the blanket.

The backpack was stuffed full of personal items such as clothing. I did not locate an ID card in the backpack. There was a plastic name tag, the type of which could be worn by an employee at a business, on which the name of "Sean Green" was written.

I spoke with Union Pacific Railroad Police Officer Frank Cortez. Officer Cortez requested I inform him of the identity of the decedent once confirmed. I did so the following day, 12/26/2018 after confirmation was made by the Medical Examiner's Office. Officer Cortez stated he would make the video from the locomotive available as soon as possible. The review of this video from the front of the train as it was travelling westbound, is pending.

Officer Cortez advised the train ID # is 0E0T523.

The above listed items are items 001-005 on the property book.

Officer Plunkett had gone to Sacred Heart Hospital. He collected the clothing items of Poyner that were removed by medical staff. I assisted Officer Plunkett in placing these items on property. These are items 006-016.

When I spoke with Medical Examiner Investigator Elizabeth Nelson on 12/26/2018, she advised Dr. Howard determined the cause of death was blunt trauma to Poyner's head, chest abdominal, and extremity areas. There were medical records indicating Poyner sought treatment on December 4th, with, among his complaints was that he felt like his body was shutting down.

A limited background check on Poyner revealed he was contacted by Riverfront Park Rangers on 10/20/2018. At that time Poyner had a misdemeanor warrant for his arrest. He displayed erratic behavior during this contact and made irrational statements. This is under incident # 2018-20209441. He was booked into jail.

Poyner showed a "general delivery" address and it appears he may have been living a transient lifestyle.

Further investigation.

On 12/26/2018 Megan Goldsmith called Crime Check and stated she had witnessed this incident. I spoke with Goldsmith over the phone on 12/31/2018. She told me the following.

She was driving her vehicle. She turned west on 2nd Avenue from Maple Street. She proceeded west on Sunset Boulevard, going past the Rosauer's Grocery Store. There was a train on the tracks next to Sunset Boulevard. She was driving an estimated 25 mph and she also estimated the train was going about the same speed as she was driving. She thought the train was going east on the tracks, to her left (as Rosauer's was on her right).

She glanced over to her left and saw what she described as a shadow figure of an adult person. She could not determine the gender. The figure was back lit, and she estimated the person had taken about three to four steps before simply disappearing from her sight. The disappearance happened immediately in front of the train. She did not see this person leap in front of, or stagger in front of the train. It appeared to her the person simply walked right in the area of the front of the train.

Goldsmith said that immediately after the person disappeared from her view, she heard the loud squeal form the train, as though the brakes were immediately applied. She continued to drive west on Sunset. As she continued to drive the train also continued, but she perceived the train to be slowing after she believed the train started to brake.

She had to go to a house on the west side of town. She believed there was a bright light on the front of the train when the person disappeared from her view. After going to a house on the west side of town, she returned back on Sunset toward downtown. Upon her return she saw that the train had stopped. There was no longer a bright light on, at front of the train. She saw an orange glow around the train and also saw that emergency vehicles responded.

I verified with her that she saw the train in front of which she saw the individual disappear, was going east. She said yes, that to the best of her memory she believed it was going east, as she was driving west on Sunset. When I inquired, she did not remember if there may have been another train that was simultaneously going in the opposite direction on a set of parallel tracks.

The following day she saw on Facebook, Spokane News, that an individual was killed on the train tracks at this location. She then called Crime Check to report she had witnessed the incident.

When I originally placed the backpack on property as item 001, I left it sealed in a plastic bag. I did this because I was aware of broken glass in the backpack and liquid, which I knew to be some type of liquor that spilled from the broken glass container.

On 01/04/2019 I retrieved the backpack. I removed all of the contents at the property facility and photographed the backpack as well as the contents. I did not find any further items of evidentiary value.

Among the items I noted was a broken "MD 20/20" glass liquor bottle, rocks and dirt, a syringe, and personal items such as clothing, toiletries, etc.

Because the contents of the liquor bottle had spilled within the backpack, I placed the contents of the backpack, along with the backpack itself, in the drying room. The items retained in the drying room are documented in photographs 31 through 55. Photographs 56 through 61 show the items which I disposed of in the garbage.

Nothing else follows at this time.

As previously documented I had been in communication with UP Railroad Police Officer Frank Cortez, regarding retrieving the video from the train locomotive. 01/22/2019 I received an email from Officer Cortez. He attached a Confidentiality Agreement he was forwarding from their Risk Management Department. It was requested I sign this agreement before they release the video to me. I have incorporated a copy of this agreement with this report. See attached.

The request for me to sign this agreement would be unlawful and in violation of Spokane Police Department Policy. The attached agreement is self-explanatory.

I responded by indicating I would not sign the agreement and would not further pursue obtaining a copy of this video. At this time Union Pacific is not willing to release the video, apparently not without my agreement to their unlawful "Confidentiality" request.

The facts of this case does not present evidence of a crime. This is the reason I would not apply for a search warrant to seize the UP video. The statements by the witnesses do not indicate anyone was with, or in proximity to, Mr. Poyner when he was struck and killed by the train. It is unknown at this time, and may never be conclusively known, if Mr. Poyner intentionally placed himself in front of the train or if he had some medical and/or psychological condition, or was alcohol/drug-impaired to the extent he simply may not have had the capacity to know the danger of his surroundings. There is no evidence indicating any unlawful actions were taken by UP personnel operating the train or anyone else, directly regarding the death of Mr. Poyner.

Case settled, with deference to the Spokane County Medical Examiner's Office for manner of death.
