ORDER 01

RESCINDING ORDERS GRANTING EXEMPTIONS FROM RULE

## BACKGROUND

On 83 separate dates between February 2, 1966, and December 28, 2001, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered orders granting requests from petitioning parties for an exemption from one of the following requirements:

- WAC 480-60-040(1), which requires railroad companies to maintain an overhead clearance of at least 22 feet 6 inches;
- WAC 480-60-050(1), which requires railroad companies to maintain a side clearance of at least 8 feet 6 inches from the center of the tracks to the nearest structure; or,
- Rules predating WAC 480-60-040(1) and WAC 480-60-050(1) that contained the same overhead and side clearance requirements.

2 Commission Staff (Staff) reviewed the records for each of these 83 petitions for exemption and found that the reasons for granting the exemptions from the side or overhead clearance rules no longer exist. Those exemptions were granted by the Commission in the following dockets:

- In each case, the railroad tracks have been removed, the building has been demolished, or some other condition exists that renders the exemption moot. See Appendix A to this order for a full description of the details related to each of the 83 exemptions.
- 4 Staff recommends rescinding the orders in each of the 83 dockets listed above. Every five years, Staff inspect close clearance locations. By rescinding the 83 orders identified in Appendix A, Staff's records will reflect only those close clearance locations currently in use, rather than listing locations that no longer exist.

## DISCUSSION

5 We agree with Staff's recommendation and rescind the orders granting petitions for exemption in each of the 83 dockets listed in Appendix A. Removing these exemptions from Commission records is consistent with the public interest because it will eliminate the administrative burden of identifying which locations are still active each time Staff performs inspections.

## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

- 6 (1) The Commission is an agency of the State of Washington having jurisdiction over public service companies, including railroad companies, within the state of Washington. RCW 80.01.040, RCW 81.01, RCW 81.04, and RCW 81.53.
- 7 (2) Staff investigated each of the 83 dockets listed in Appendix A where an order granting exemption was previously entered and recommends that those orders be rescinded.
- 8 (3) This matter came before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on February 15, 2019.
- 9 (4) After reviewing the materials provided by Staff and giving due consideration, the Commission finds that rescinding the orders previously granting exemptions in all 83 dockets listed in Appendix A is in the public interest. The previous orders should be rescinded.

## ORDER

- THE COMMISSION ORDERS That the orders granting exemptions from
  WAC 480-60-040 and WAC 480-60-050 previously entered in each of the 83 dockets
  listed in Appendix A are rescinded as of the effective date of this Order.
- 11 The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter this Order.
