Re: Review Committee Decision - Case Number

Dear Mr. Johnson:

The Washington State Dig Law Safety Committee received a complaint regarding a potential violation of the Washington State Dig Law RCW 19.122.030 for work performed on 11/13/18.

On February 20, 2019 the Washington State Dig Law Safety Committee Review Board heard complaint Case 18-092 Bayview Meadows Community Assn. vs Andrew's LandShapers.

The Review Committee determined that the respondent did violate RCW 19.122.030(2), for failing to request a valid locate prior to excavation.

The Review Committee recommends the following penalty be assessed to the respondent:

 \$1000.00 penalty for one violation of RCW 19.122.030(2)

The Committee recommends a penalty of \$1000 with \$800 deferred on the condition that Andrew Damerau attends NUCA dig safe training and have no additional violation of RCW 19.122 within 12 months of receiving a penalty assessment order.
