Commercial Ferry Application Question 13 Response: Conditions that exist which would justify the granting of a Certificate of Public convenience and Necessity:

Jack Raines, the current owner of Lake Chelan Boat Company, has operated this service for 35 years and it is time to sell the service and retire from the ferry service. He supports Discover Lake Chelan, LLC and believes they have the valuable skills to successfully operate this service.

Mr. Raines' goal is to have the "Lady of the Lake" passenger service continue on Lake Chelan and hopes that this transition can happen in a timely fashion to achieve this goal.

Commercial Ferry Application Question 15 Response: State applicant's prior experience, if any, in providing commercial ferry service:

Reed Courtney has been a back up Captain for the Lake Chelan Boat Company vessels for 2 months now. He will continue to work in this capacity during this transition of ownership. Reed grew up in Stehekin and has traveled on the Lake Chelan Boat Company vessels his entire life. He is familiar with all landings, procedures, and very knowledgeable of safety procedures. He has held his Captain's license for 15 years, operating all those years on Lake Chelan.

Reed owns and operates the barge service on the lake. He has traveled Lake Chelan and made barge landings for 20 years in all areas that are served by the Lake Chelan Boat Company vessels. He has a vast knowledge of the weather conditions that can change abruptly.

Brun Garfoot was also raised in Stehekin, and now lives in Chelan/Manson. He holds an MBA degree, along with a mechanical engineering degree. He is also very knowledgeable of the lake, knows the business up and down the lake, and has worked with Mountain Barge Service (Reed Courtney) in depth for several years helping to grow that company. Brun's strengths are in operations management, sales and marketing, and organization development. He will operate more in the financials, business integration and operational controls capacity, at which he is excellent.

The combination of these two men, who have a strong desire to safely and responsibly serve their home region are a perfect match for this unique and necessary service. Above and beyond, they have desires to enhance opportunities at both ends of the lake and in between, with an extreme desire to keep rates as reasonable as possible, while enhancing the passengers experience.

Also, as stated in the sale transfer agreements, all current Lake Chelan Boat Company management, captains, and staff will be retained by Discover Lake Chelan LLC. This will make the transition very smooth and safe, which will be good for the traveling public.

Commercial Ferry Application Question 16 Response: All Items






