This is to notify you of a proposed rate change for commercial services in the City of Everett and portions of Snohomish County where Rubatino Refuse Removal, Inc. operates. Should the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) approve our request customers will experience a rate increase throughout all classes of service.

As you may know, it has been nearly five years since our last general rate case. In that time Rubatino Refuse Removal, Inc. has experienced increases in costs that are key to delivering services; including labor, pension, fuel and maintenance costs. In addition, the company continues to acquire new assets to ensure it can deliver the safest, most efficient service possible. If approved, the proposed rates will become effective August 1, 2019.

The proposed rate increases for our Commercial, Multi-family, & Roll-off services is about 5.75% and not all services are listed above.

The commission has the authority to set final rates that may be either lower or higher from the company's request, depending on the results of its investigation.
